2. The memoranda listed in paragraph 1 are hereby rescinded.



4. Authorization for additions, changes, or discontinuance of aeronautical aids will be provided by procurement instrument only, in accordance with SCAPIN 1872, as amended, and, when appropriate, in accordance with SCAPIN 1299, as amended. In the case of radio aeronautical aids, authorization for additions, changes, or discontinuance will also be obtained as provided by SCAPIN 1744, as amended.

5. Direct communication between the Civil Communications Section, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers, and the Ministry of Telecommunications, regarding matters within the scope of this memorandum, is authorized.
