Clearance of Field Information in Compliance with OWI Regulation 1

The Secretary of Agriculture, in Memorandum No. 1025, made the Director of Information responsible for carrying out the directives in Office of War Information Regulation No. 1. This Memorandum interprets the OWI regulation and field directive, and sets up a system of compliance to facilitate clearance with the OWI of War Information released by Department field information workers and to reduce clearance to the necessary minimum. To accomplish this the Department Office of Information and the Office of War Information have worked out the following procedures:

The USDA Office of Information, Field Service, regional offices, will assist in arranging for such clearances, but prior clearance with the Field Service offices will not be required. Primary responsibility for conforming with OWI regulations remains upon the issuing USDA agency. However, appropriate regional offices of the USDA Office of Information should be furnished with two copies of everything issued by USDA field offices for press, radio or other public use. (Sets of photos and expensive or elaborate visual material are not required.) This will enable the USDA Field Service to assist, with advisory review, in assuring USDA compliance with OWI regulations. A list of USDA information regional offices is attached. Any difficulty involving clearance of information with OWI should be promptly reported to the appropriate USDA Information Field Service office, in order that immediate effort may be made to compose the difficulty.

Cooperative Extension Service workers handle some Department of Agriculture, as well as State information. It would be in the interest of complete compliance with the Office of War Information as well as protection to Extension workers releasing Department information for Cooperative Extension workers to follow the same procedures outlined for direct Federal employees.

This memorandum, which is issued with OWI concurrence, should be brought to the attention of responsible administrators in the field, and their information officers, in connection with Secretarial Memorandum No. 1025 which was sent to you recently with Office of War Information Regulation No. 1, and instructions issued by OWI's News Bureau amplifying the policy of field clearance outlined in Regulation 1.

Most war-related information released by USDA field agencies will be secondary; that is, based upon or adapted from primary information, issuance of which will already have been cleared with OWI in Washington.
This need not be cleared again. Thus the number of field clearances required with OWI will be small.

However, information originating at local or regional levels will sometimes be of classes required to be checked with OWI News Bureau field offices for their clearance and release. In day-to-day operation it is impracticable to refer every question for prior decision, so the question of whether clearance is required must generally be answered within the judgment of the responsible USDA field official. Therefore, each item of public information for any medium should be examined with the following criteria (Section 12 of OWI Regulation 1) in mind:

- 1) Is this <u>secondary</u> information—based upon or adapted from material already cleared? If so, it may be released.
- 2) Is this within clearly defined policy and exclusively within the authorized activities of the USDA? If so, it may be released. (NOTE: Information affecting activities of another Department agency should be checked with such agency before release.) For example, releasable items would include "how to do it" information, market news service, terms of new programs and reports of progress in same.
- 3) Is this <u>primary</u> information related definitely to war activities or policy, or does it include material broader than the authorized activities of the USDA? If so, it should be cleared with the nearest OWI News Bureau field office, and issued by that office unless the originating USDA agency is asked to issue the release. For example, a locally-originated (primary) statement on effects of price control or rationing, in which OPA or WPB is involved.

In the list of UWI News Bureau field offices enclosed, regional and State offices of USDA agencies are assigned to specified OWI offices for clearance and release of those USDA items which come within the OWI regulations. If it is felt that a different assignment will be more convenient the USDA Office of Information in Washington should be notified and assignments may be changed.

Where there is no local OWI News Bureau office, and it makes for more efficient operation of an agency to do so, the regional News Bureau officer will, with the concurrence of the appropriate USDA administrative official, designate a USDA information officer to clear and issue for OWI material relating to that agency. It is requested that all Department personnel assist OWI in any appropriate way.

County USDA offices will seldom have items requiring OWI clearance. Each USDA agency or bureau is expected to arrange through its own lines for its county or similar subordinate offices to make necessary clearances.


