This has reference to your letter of April 2, 1964 concerning Joseph and Reva BERNSTEIN.

2. No doubt this couple are identical to the BERNSTEINs mentioned in our exchange of correspondence under our reference D 933-2328 (your file 100-1134). This deals with requests from your office for the names of registered owners for two automobiles observed at the home of Joseph BERNSTEIN in Detroit, in 1958 and again in 1961. Investigation at that time revealed that Reva BERNSTEIN has a sister, Zelda (Mrs. David Alkin) ROBINSON, residing at Hamilton, Ontario.

3. With regard to the request outlined in your letter under reference, we are having enquiries carried out at Hamilton in an effort to determine if Joseph and Reva BERNSTEIN were visiting that point in November 1963. Also, should it be learned that they were in Canada, our investigation will be extended to determine if, in fact, they were interviewed as stated. You will be advised promptly of our findings.

4. Meanwhile, we might mention that from a review of records at this Headquarters, no information

Meanwhile, we might mention that from a review of records at this Headquarters, no information was located which would in any way substantiate the statements made by Mrs. BERNSTEIN, indicating that she and her husband had been interviewed in Canada following the assassination of President Kennedy.

5. In keeping with your request, this matter is being handled expeditiously.
