Also informs of airfields to be used by Maj Ewing and party, i.e., to Wonsan prior to 1 Nov and to Yonpo thereafter Telephone call to Base Opns, Ashiya AB, 1300 hrs, 31 Oct, disclosed that Maj Ewing and party departed 31 Oct, prior to call. Maj Ewing arrived X Corps 30 Oct, per his report rec'd 2 Nov.

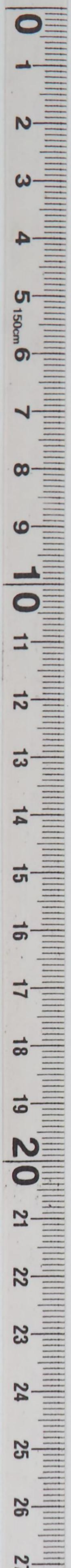
