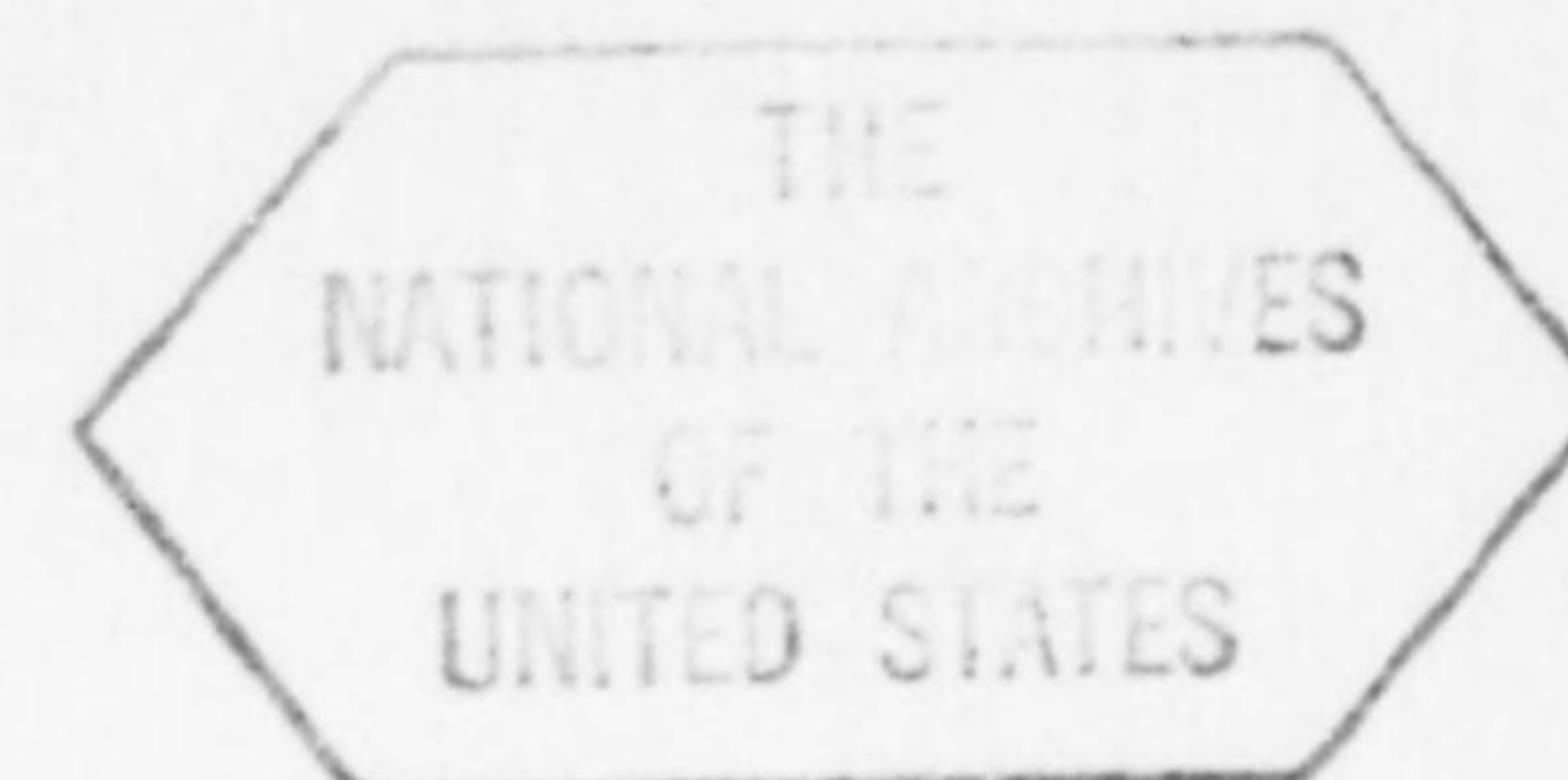

Subject bill would amend the Marine Pilot Law (Law No. 121 of 1949) by relaxing the requirements for Marine Pilots to obtain licenses. Discretion is delegated to the Ministry to fix certain of the qualifications by Ministerial Ordinance. Although it would be preferable if the qualifications could be fixed by the law, no serious legal objection is made to the limited delegation involved in this bill. As far as the other amendments are concerned, they would seem to be purely policy matters within the jurisdiction of G-2/PSD.

Public Service as Submitted by the House of
Representatives

1. The Civil Service Division disapproves the attached proposed amendment.
2. Disapproval is based upon the fact that the proposed amendment would remove a technical function from the National Personnel Authority and place it in the hands of the Diet. The Diet members are neither trained nor equipped to pass judgment on the technical administrative functions which must be handled by a group properly trained and technically qualified to conduct necessary studies, draw conclusions from such technical studies, and make specific recommendations based upon such technical findings.
3. Only one of two courses may be deduced from the proposed amendment:
 - a. The Diet members intend to take the recommendations of the National Personnel Authority upon the determination and establishment of occupations and occupational groups arrived at through technical classification methods and thereby merely become a rubber stamp for the National Personnel Authority, adding one further administrative delay in the process, without technical gain to the program, or
 - b. The Diet members intend to establish a special technical committee at the Diet level which will superimpose its thinking and will on the technical operations of NPA and thus, for all practical purposes, entirely eliminate the need for the entire classification operation in the NPA.
4. Either one of the above suppositions is untenable in a modern personnel system; complete duplication, adding increased expenses to the taxpayer without any gain whatsoever to the operation; and entirely without precedent in any other democracy in the world. In the case of the United States, it doesn't even have any precedents in any of the state or municipal merit systems now in operation.

5. The entire proposed amendment is covered by the above comments and thus is disapproved in toto.



1. Proposed redraft of the attached amendment submitted under the date of 15 March 1950 has been evolved with the assistance of Dr. Asai of the National Personnel Authority and eliminates some of the worst features of the previously submitted suggested amendment.
2. Under the circumstances, and in the interest of meeting some of the Diet's objections to the proposed Classification Law, the Civil Service Division will agree to the addition of this amendment to the proposed Classification Law as presented by the National Personnel Authority. It should be noted for the record, however, that in the opinion of the Civil Service Division, the former objections as voiced in a previous memorandum concerning this amendment, are still valid as they apply to remaining applicable parts of this latest proposal. However, the Civil Service Division will leave, for future work with the Diet committees, the possibility of securing a later amendment to remove the objectionable sections after the Law has been enacted.
3. This proposed amendment may be returned to the Japanese with the statement that the Civil Service Division will voice no objection at this time to this proposal.



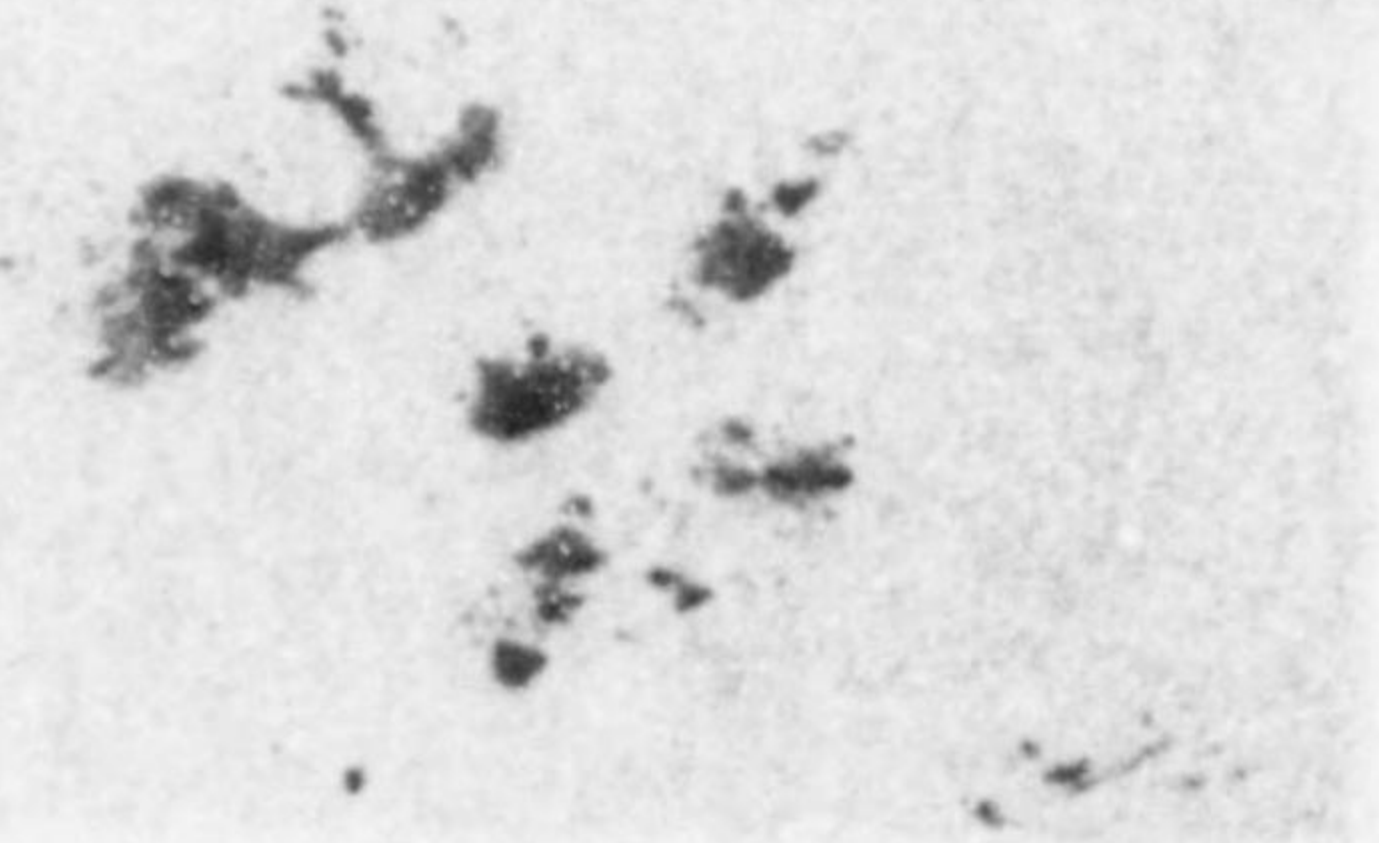



MEMORANDUM FOR : The Record

SUBJECT : Proposed Amendment to the Bill for Partial
Amendment to the Law for the Fixed Number
of Personnel in the Administrative Organs.

1. At approximately 1745 on 2 May 1950, Capt. Norris, Parliamentary and Political Division, Government Section, personally brought the subject amendment to the Civil Service Division for consideration and comment.
2. The proposed amendment is a member-sponsored bill, proposed by UMEZU, Kinichi (Socialist), and recommends the partial amendment to the Law for the Fixed Number of Personnel in the Administrative Organs by deleting paragraphs 13 and 14 of the Supplementary Provisions of the original bill.
3. In view of the fact that the proposed amendment merely places the regular service national employees back under the operations of Articles 82 to 92 inclusive, of the National Public Service Law, the Civil Service Division interposes no objection to the recommended amendment.
4. Capt. Norris was immediately so advised by Mr. MacCoy on 2 May 1950.
