Por la goleta Estados Unidos procedente a Veracruz hemos recibido diarios de aquella plaza que atacan al 1.º de Septiembre: no contienen noticias de mayor importancia.

En consecuencia de tan robustos fundamentos pedimos a E. S. M. Sr. vicepresidente como necesario para llevar a cabo la grandiosa obra que emprendió en Jalapa, se sirva iniciar a la cámara por conducto de V. E. los artículos siguientes:
1.º Los individuos que no merecen la opinion pública en la cámara de diputados y senadores y que con hechos posteriores han agravado su conducta anterior, son los siguientes:—Diputados, D. Herrera, Brocena, Basadre, Valle (D. Fernando) Bernades, Palommo, Anaya (D. Pedro) Ulloa, Quintana, (D. Matias) Quintana Roo, Moreno, Salvatierra, Garcia Tato, Escudero, Plata, Baso, Garmendia, Ordas y Guido de Güido.—Los honorables señores Rejon, Acosta y Viesca, y otros empleados y funcionarios públicos, así civiles como militares, marcados por la mia. ma opinion, como el famoso Biouda &c.

2.º El gobierno tiene por conveniente que se tome en consideracion las representaciones hechas por el ejército en distintos puntos de la república, aconsejando de paso a los diputados y senadores expresados para el cumplimiento del artículo 4 del plan de Jalapa.
La guarnicion de México invita a los congresos y guarniciones de los Estados, para que secundándolo, inicien al congreso general y represente el supremo gobierno la necesidad de llevar a cabo el citado artículo 4, como el único que puede salvar a la nacion en las presentes circunstancias.

El ejército del Rey ha triunfado. La suerte de Argel está decidida desde ayer: el pabellón del Rey flamea ya sobre todas las fortalezas y sobre el palacio del D. y. Relativo a la comunicacion anterior, la Quadienne dice: "La question europea, agitada hace siglos, está ya resuelta."

Convenio entre el general en jefe del ejército francés y S. A. el Dey de Argel.
El Castillo de cassaba, todas las fortalezas que dependian de Argel, el puerto y la ciudad serán entregadas a las tropas francesas hoy a las 10 de la mañana.
El general en jefe de las tropas francesas promete a su Alteza el Dey de Argel de darle libre y en posesion de todo aquello que le pertenezca personalmente.
El Dey tendrá la facultad de retirarse donde guste con su familia y todo lo que le pertenece todo el tiempo que permanezca en Argel y toda su familia estarán bajo la proteccion del ejército francés; se le quedará una guardia para la seguridad de su persona y su familia. El general en jefe promete a todos los soldados las mismas ventajas e igual proteccion.
Quedará en su libre ejercicio la religion Mahometana. La libertad de los habitantes de todas clases, su religion, sus propiedades, su comercio, y su industria, serán inviolables. Sus esposas serán respetadas.
El general en jefe se promete bajo su honor.
El oage del presente convenio se hará hoy a las 10 de la mañana, y las tropas francesas tomarán inmediatamente posesion del castillo de cassaba, y sucesivamente de las fortalezas de la ciudad, y del puerto. Campo frente a Argel, 5 de julio 1830.

una carta del almirante Duperré del 3 de julio comunicando que ordenó al almirante Rosamel efectuar un falso ataque sobre las baterías enemigas del lado del mar, con el fin de distraer la atención de los Argelinos.
Una segunda carta fechada el 6 de julio, abordo de la Provasca da cuenta de las operaciones marítimas del modo siguiente:
"Al siguiente día 4, despues del ataque dado por la flota bajo mis órdenes contra las fortalezas y baterías de Argel, con el intento de que acudiesen a la ciudad los artilleros y los soldados Argelinos que venia a dirigiran un gran número acia el fuerte del emperador, las baterías de la flota rompieron de nuevo sus fuegos a las trece de la mañana. A las 10 despues de una terrible explosion cuyo ruido se oyó a una distancia de 60 millas vimos que una parte del fuerte estaba destruido y nuestras tropas tomando posesion. Me proponia renovar el ataque, pero los vientos contrarios habiendome forzado a suspender este proyecto, villegar un barco parlamentario que conduca a su bordo el almirante de la flota Argelina."
Los detalles que da aquí el almirante Duperré son relativos a la suspencion de hostilidades semejantes a las que se verá en la comunicacion del general en jefe.
"Hoy he hecho fundear la Provasca bajo los muros de Argel. Los otros buques que forman dos divisiones al mando del almirante Rosamel y el capitán Ponce están cruzando frente a las bahías de Argel y de Sidi-Feruch."
"Mi primer cuidado fue el reclamar los legracidos prisioneros de la Sylens y la Aventura los que se me entregaron y los envié para Francia. Estos han padecido mucho, pero estos males emanan mas bien de la exasperacion del populacho que del Dey. No obstante, ninguno de los que escaparon de la matanza hecha por los Argelinos, cuya lista os remito han subido bajo el peso de otros sufrimientos."

REPUBLICA ARGENTINA.
Buenos Ayres, 5 de junio.—La tranquilidad de pais no ha sido turbado por ningun acontecimiento político. No ha vuelto aun el gobernador de la provincia del interior. Según los últimos avisos él se hallaba todavía en Salto.
El senador José María Rjas ha sido nombrado diputado del gobierno de Buenos Ayres, para tratar junta mente con los de Santa-Fe, Entre Rios y corriente, de la paz definitiva y de una alianza entre las cuatro provincias, conforme a las estipulaciones preliminares del último tratado.

BRASIL.
Rio Janeiro, 5 de julio.—En lo adelante se propone el gobierno exigir que el pago de los derechos de aduana se haga en moneda de cañera y la otra en billete de banco.
El cuerpo legislativo está actualmente discutiendo un proyecto de ley acerca del papel-moeda.
Idem. 7 de idem.—Somos informados de los primeros efectos de la discordia que divide a las gefes ambiciosos y turbulentos del nuevo gobierno de Montevideo, se han llegado a las manos los partidos, hubo una seccion entre las tropas del gobierno y las del general Rivero que manda en el interior; se dice que Dn. Manuel Lavalleye hermano del gobernador de Montevideo fue hecho prisionero. El gobernador en persona, despues de haber fortificado la plaza dejando ademas la ciudadela con una fuerte guarnicion, se puso en marcha con un rejimiento de cazadores y todas las tropas disponibles, con el intento de batre a su adversario.
