**4 676 Power generators** offered, of which **1763** from the **rescEU stockpile**



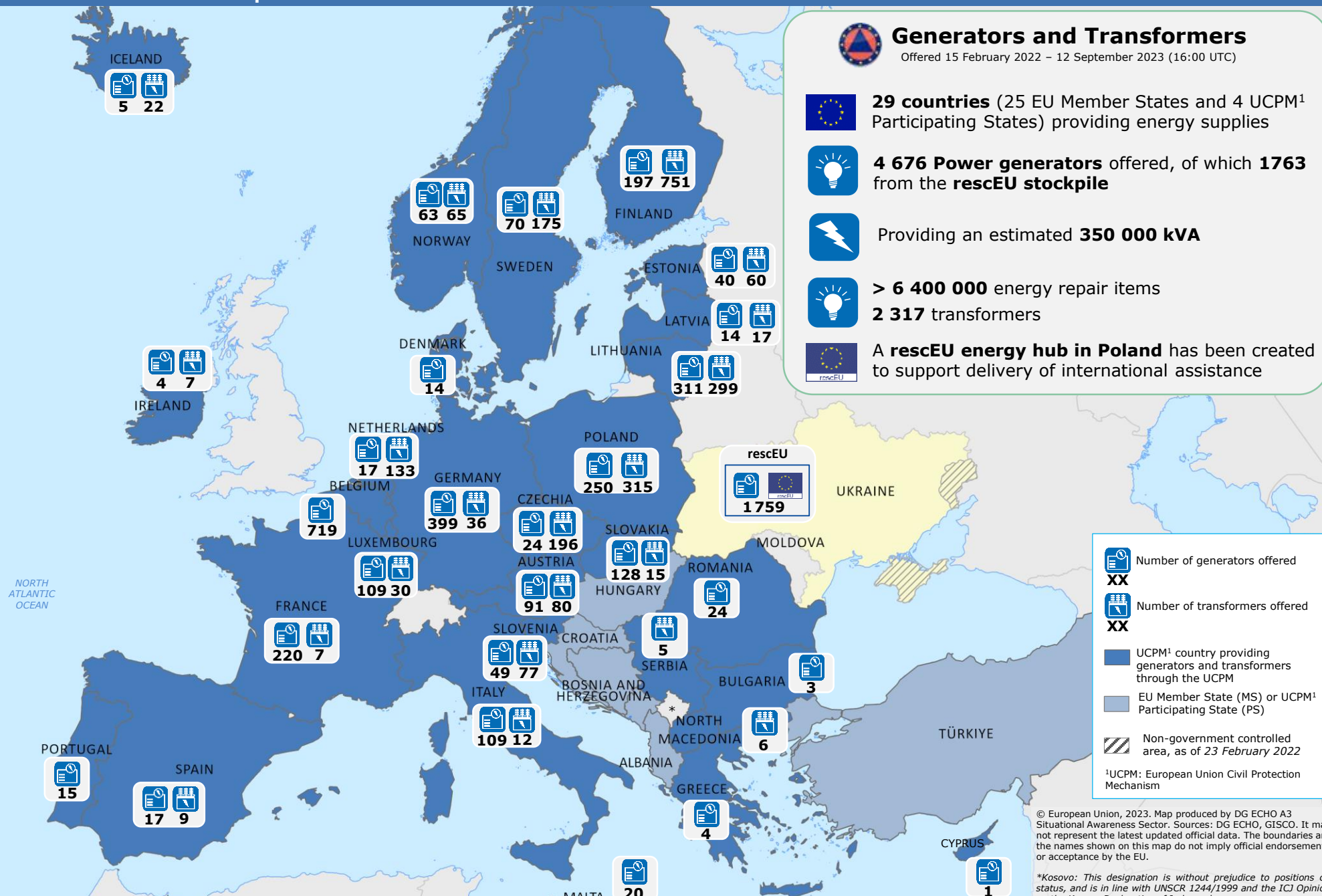
Providing an estimated **350 000 kVA**
