## AN ACT

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
That all p persons held to service or lathe within the $Q_{\text {strict of bobumbiai Io y reason }}$ Nit african decent are hereby discharged and freed of and from all claim to such service or labor; and from and after the praseage of this act neither slavery nor ins
 Whale hereafter exist in said Qistriet. Sec. \&. And be it further enacted, that all per= -dons loyal to the limited states holding claims to service or labor against persons discharged therefrom by this act may, within ninety days from the passage thereof but mit thereafter present to the boninissioners hereinafter mentioned their respective statements on petitions in smiting verified by oath or affirmation. *ting forth the name ages, and personal description of enoch persons the mas $=$ -new in nohich ka id pobotioners acquired encteclaim, shod any foots toweling the valve thereof and declaring his ablegïance to the government of the limited

And be it further ended, that the President- of the Merited stater. with the advice and consents of the dentate, shall appoint Bro commissioners. residents of the District of botrmbia, any two of whom shall have power to wets whee shall reeve the petitions above snempioned, and who shall investigate and determine the oatidity and value of the claims therein presented as afocecaid, and ap= praise and apparition, under the proviso hereto annexed. The value in money of the several claims by them found to be valid: Proirded, however, That the entire som es reappraised and approvitined shall mot-exeeed in the aggregate an amount equal to/thre hundred dollars for each person shown to have been so held by lawtulctaim:

And provided finthin that no elaine shall e be allowed for anis slave or slaver brought into said Qistriet - after the passage of this aet nor for any slave claimed by any person who has bore arsis against the government of the Lenilect skates in the present rebellion or in any way given aid or comport thereto; or which orig. inates in or by virtue of any transfer heretofore made, or which shall hereafter be secede by any prison who has in any manner aided or sustained the rebellion against the government of the lessited slates. subpoena and compel the attendance of witnesses, un d to receive testimony and enforce its production as in civil cases before counts of justice, without the exclusion of any witness on account of color; and then may summon before them the persons making claim to service or labor, and examine them under oath; and they may also, for proposes of iclentification and appraizernent, call be fore them the persons es clainued. Said commissioners shall approint-a clerk. who shall keep files and complete record of all proceedings before them, who shall have power to administer oaths and affirmations in said procec⿻inge, and who shall issue all lawful process by them ordered. The marstral of the District of lo ole mia shall personally. or by depruiz, attend upon the sessions of said commissioners, and shale execute the process issued by said clerk. See. 6. And be it further enacted, That said commissioners shall receive in compensation \&or their services the 2 um of two thousand dol= lars each, to be paid upore the filing of their report- thatsaid clerk shall receive for his services the em of two hundred dot lasher month that said marshal shall receive sushbees as are allowed by law for similar sesvices presfonmed by him in the circin't-coun- of the (a) istrict of botumbia; that the secure =Cary of the treasury shall cause all other reasonable expenses of said commission to be audited and allowed, and that said com= = sensation \&ees, and expenses shall be paid from the treasury of the united stales. Aec.'\%, And be it further enacted. That for the purpose of carrying this act into effest-there is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise aleprofiriated, a am not exceeding one million of dollars. See. d. And be it qunthermaeted, That any person or persons who shall kidnaps, or in any manner transport or procure to be taken out of said District any person os persons disehaiged and freed by the pRovisions of this act or any fee person or person k wite intent to re-enslave or sell such per son or herons into slavery, or shall re-enslave ann of said freed persons. the person on hersons so offending shall be deemed gaily of a felony, and on conviction thereof in ann const of competent

Jurisdiction in said Bistriel shall be imprisoned in the penitentiary not less than five nor more than twenty years. Sec.9. And be it further maced, the within twenty days, or within such further inc as the commissioners herein provided for shale limit, after the passage of this act- a statement in suiting on setioinle shall be filed with the clentr of the circuit courtfor the district of Columbia by the several owner of claimants lo. the services of the persons made free or mane - milted by this act, setting forth the names. ages. Dec.11. And be it further enacted. That the sum of one hundred thou sand dollars, out of any money in the heasuny not other= vise appropriated is hereby appropriated to be expended under the direction of the President of the Lenited Slates, to aid in the colonization and settlement of such free persons of African descent now residing in said (b) istriel including those to be liberated by this act us may desire to emigrate to the Republien of Hbanyti or Siberia, or suet other country beyond the limits of the Mmiled SLates as the President may determine: Provided. The expenditure for this purpose shall not exceed one hundred dollars for each emiqpant.-Aee. 12. And be it further enacted. That
all acts of congress and all lams of the oleate of mary $=$ = land in force in said (D)istrid, and all ordinances of the cities of Washington and Georgetown inconsident with the provisions of this aet are hereby repealed.
