SUMMARY OF CONTENTS

Deaths of Allied Prisoners in Mukden Prisoner of War Camp
(Doc 2824)

This item lists 184 Allied prisoners who died in the Japanese Prisoner of War Camp at Mukden during the period 1942 to 1945. This information was obtained by translation of records maintained by the Japanese medical authorities at the camp. The following data is given on each man: name, rank, prisoner of war number, age, nationality, place of capture, weight at time of entry into camp, last weight recorded before death and cause and date of death. 181 of the victims were Americans, two were British and one was Australian.

There is no evidence to show whether these men received adequate medical care as defined in the articles of the Geneva Convention. However, the cause-of-death column indicates that the majority died of diseases resulting from severe malnutrition, such as beri-beri and enteritis. This implicates both the Japanese medical and administrative staffs of the camp.

Three of the Americans are listed as dying from "bullet wounds" on 31 July 1943. No details of these shootings are given. Eighteen deaths on 7 December 1944 are attributed to an Allied bombing attack that morning.

Other documents which will complement this item are now in the process of translation. They will provide a roster of Allied prisoners of war at Mukden and thus aid in tracing men who have not been accounted for. In addition, names and other data on the Japanese officials of the camp will also be given.

NOTE: This report supplements information given in PACMIRS War Crimes Information Series No. 9. (PACMIRS Documents No 2820, 2821), dated 8 Mar 1946.

DEATHS OF ALLIED PRISONERS
IN MUKDEN PRISONER OF WAR CAMP

Editor's Note

Following is a list of names and other pertinent data on 184 American, British and Australian prisoners who died at Mukden Prisoner of War Camp between 12 November 1942 and 15 August 1945. This information was extracted from a looseleaf file of handwritten medical records kept by the Japanese authorities of the camp. The names have been arranged here in alphabetical order.

The English version of some of the names could not be determined. In these cases, an exact ROMAJI transliteration of the original KATAKANA is given, followed by an asterisk. Where the English version was doubtful, a possible rendering is given, followed by an exact ROMAJI transliteration in parentheses.

Some of the names listed in this report were listed in PACMIRS War Crimes Information Series No 9 (PACMIRS Documents No 2820, 2821), dated 8 Mar 1946. These names are indicated by the symbol # followed by a number representing the number of the Death Certificate in the above mentioned publication. Example: #8 PIGDON, Douglas C indicates that this name appeared in the previous publication as Death Certificate No 8. Discrepancies noted between the two listings of some names etc. are due to variation in the originals.
