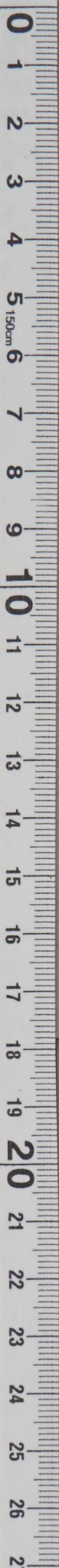

1. TM 38-403 requires that WD AGO Form No. 446 be used by an activity as a requisition and issue media when supplies and repair parts are issued from the supply branch to the repair shop.
2. However, in practice it has been determined that the use of WD AGO Form No. 446 does not meet the requirements of rebuild shops of BIG-5. As a consequence a form has been prepared which, by actual use, does meet the requirements of WD AGO Form No. 446 and also includes additional columns for the entry of data essential for rebuild operations including fiscal pricing, amounts required per vehicle or major assembly, three-day level, etc.
3. The use of WD AGO Form No. 446 seriously impedes the line requisitioning and issues, whereas the form in use materially aids and simplifies these steps.
4. However, under the pertinent regulations, WD AGO Form No. 446 is the only form authorized to be used and the use of locally prepared form would result in disallowed or suspended vouchers by the Property Auditor.
5. It is accordingly requested that the use of "Daily Line Inventory and Requisition," copy inclosed, be authorized by your headquarters for use at BIG-5 installations for the supply of repair parts to Plant Rebuild Shops.

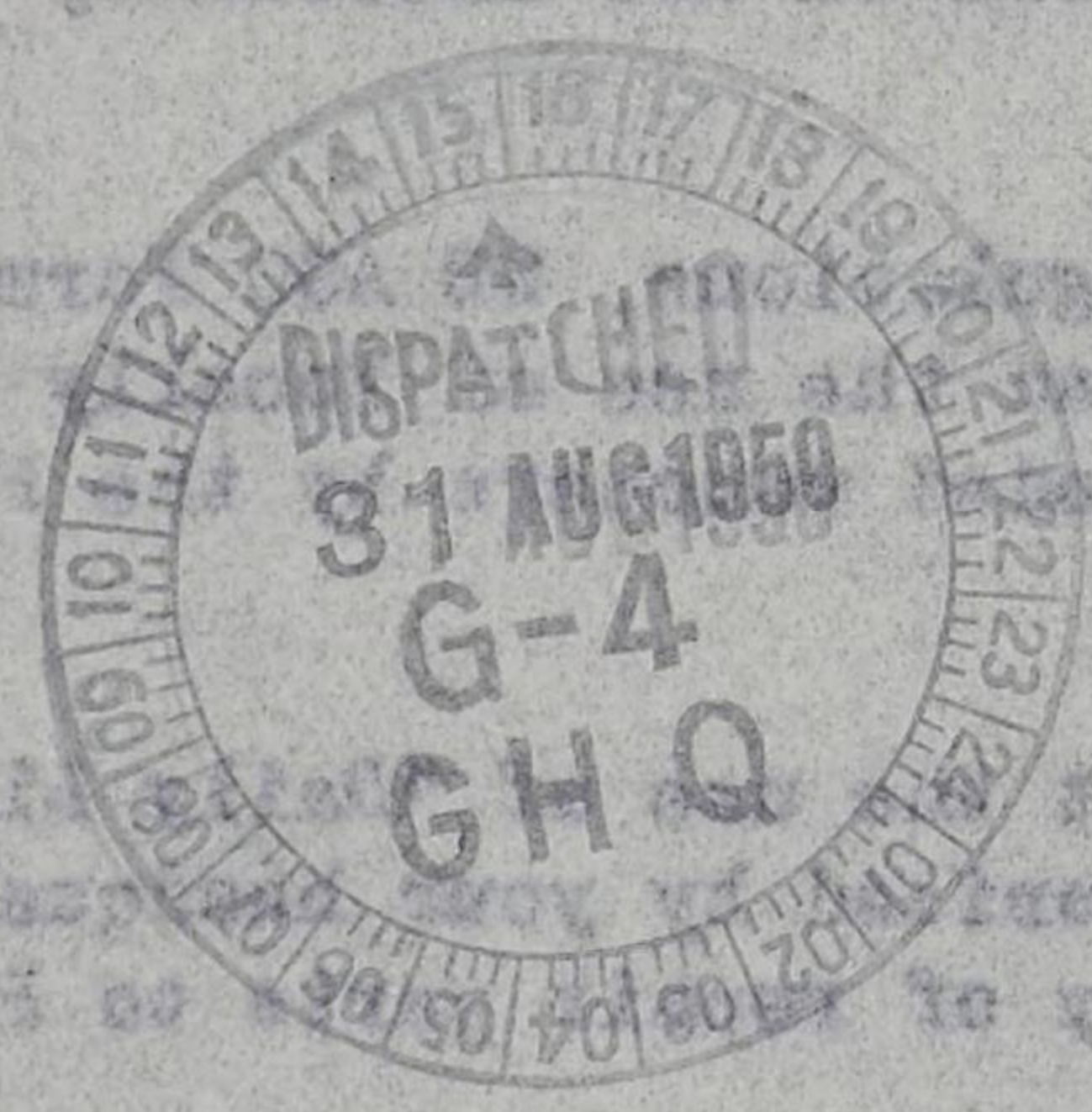

1. The 440 343 form is used by an activity as a requisition and issue form and results are derived from the supply branch to the receipt area.
2. However, it is noted that the use of 440 343 does not meet the requirements of requisition forms of 440 343. A comparison of 440 343 and 440 343 shows that the requisition form of 440 343 includes additional columns for the entry of data essential for requisitioning and issue, whereas the form in use materially omits and simplifies these items.

3. It is accordingly requested that "copy included" be authorized for use of 440 343 installations for the entry of requisitioning and issue data.
4. However, since the requisitioning and issue form is the only form authorized to be used and the 440 343 form would result in duplication of effort, it is recommended that the 440 343 form be discontinued.

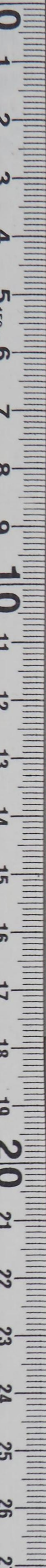

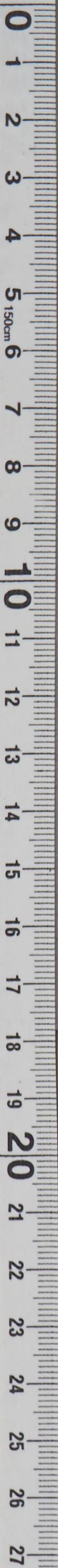

CONTRACT FOR OFF DUTY ACADEMIC INSTRUCTION
DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY

CONTRACT NO.

CONTRACTOR:

Fixed-price contract for instruction of

Payments to be made by the Finance Officer, U.S. Army.

This contract is negotiated pursuant to Section 2 (c) (5), Armed Services Procurement Act of 1947 (Act of February 19, 1948 (Pub. Law 413-80th Cong.)).

THIS CONTRACT, entered into this _____ day of _____, 19____, by THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter called the Government, represented by the Contracting Officer executing this contract, and _____ organized and existing under the laws of the _____ of the city of _____, hereinafter called the Contractor, witnesseth that the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1. SERVICES TO BE FURNISHED. - (a) The Contractor shall enroll and provide instruction during the period of _____ to _____ for students as required by the Government who shall be _____ of the Department of the Army of the United States selected by the Government as acceptable to and approved by the Contractor in the courses on grades and for the respective periods of time determined as hereinafter provided.

(b) All students accepted by the Contractor shall be enrolled in the same manner as other students and shall be subject to the same academic regulations, and shall have the same privileges including use of all facilities and equipment normally furnished by the Contractor to all students.

(c) Requests by the Government for instruction shall be made by written introductions of students by name, and shall constitute an order to this contract.

(d) Such order shall cover one or more students, shall be presented to the Contractor (i) by the student at time of enrollment or (ii) by the Contracting Officer prior to enrollment of students, shall designate the curriculum of the student and fixed sum-total portion of the costs to be assumed by the Contracting Officer.

(e) Each such order shall bear numbered office identification bearing appropriate prefix. Such identification shall be assigned in sequence from a register or registers established by the Contracting Officer. In the event it is desired to amend an order issued hereunder for any reason such amendment shall be clearly identified on its face by the word "Amendment", shall bear the same number as the original order and suffixed in alphabetical sequence of occurrence. Such amendments shall be furnished the Contractor in sufficient copies to permit the Contractor's signature of approval (*retaining one (1) copy for his files*) and return to the Contracting Officer.

ARTICLE 2. CONSIDERATION, PAYMENT, AND INVOICES. - (a) The Government will pay to the Contractor as compensation, the cost of the course of instruction of each student as set forth in the order covering his enrollment, which cost will in no event be a greater amount per student than that charged for other students pursuing the same or sim-

ilar curriculum: PROVIDED: That, if the Contractor regularly charges higher rates of tuition for students who are not residents of the state in which the Contractor is located, the Contractor may charge the Government not in excess of the lowest rates applicable to such nonresident students.

(b) The Contractor will submit to the Contracting Officer an invoice against each order issued against this contract, in quintuplicate for pre-audit and forwarding thru channels to the Finance Officer indicated on the cover page of this contract. Invoices shall have the following certificate placed thereon and shall be signed by such representative or representatives of the Contractor as shall be authorized by the Contractor:

"I certify that the charges stated herein are correct and just; that payment therefor has not been received; that all statutory requirements as to American production and labor standards and all conditions of purchase applicable to the transaction have been complied with; that State or local taxes are not included; and that the foregoing charges are in accordance with the established rates of the Contractor."

(c) Invoices may be submitted to cover a semester or period of instruction at any time after the expiration of the Contractor's regularly established period of student eligibility for refund upon withdrawal.

(d) Payment on any such invoice will be deemed to be in complete discharge of the Government's obligation under this contract relative to the students named thereon, to the extent of the semester or period of instruction covered by such invoice.

ARTICLE 3. TEXTBOOKS, EQUIPMENT, AND SUPPLIES. - Unless otherwise provided herein, all necessary textbooks, laboratory manuals, and other equipment which will be required for use by individual students will be procured by said students at their own expense; except that students included herein shall have the same privileges to free-of-charge issuance of text books, laboratory manuals, and other equipment as may be regularly provided for by the Contractor.

ARTICLE 4. TERMINATION. - (a) The performance of work under this contract may be terminated by the Government in accordance with this article in whole, or from time to time in part, whenever, (i) the Contracting Officer shall determine that any such termination is for the best interests of the Government, or (ii) the student voluntarily, or at the request of the Contractor, withdraws from any course or courses. Whenever termination is effected pursuant to (i) above, Contracting Officer shall deliver to the Contractor a notice of termination specifying the extent to which performance of work under this contract shall be terminated and the effective date of such termination. Whenever termination is effected under (ii) above, the Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer of such withdrawal and the effective date thereof.

(b) In the event of termination in whole or in part, the Contractor shall be paid (i) all fees then due and owing and theretofore unpaid, and (ii) all accrued fees, in accordance with the established policies of the Contractor if termination is effected during any period of instruction.

ARTICLE 5. DISPUTES. - Except as otherwise specifically provided in this contract, any dispute concerning a question of fact, arising under this contract which is not disposed of by agreement shall be decided by the Contracting Officer, who shall reduce his decision to writing and mail or otherwise furnish a copy thereof to the Contractor. Within 30 days from the date of receipt of such copy, the Contractor may appeal by mailing or otherwise furnishing to the Contracting Officer a written appeal addressed to the Secretary, and the decision of the Secretary or his duly authorized representative for the hearing of such appeals shall be final and conclusive; Provided that, if no such appeal is taken, the decision of the Contracting Officer shall be final and conclusive. In connection with any appeal proceeding under this clause, the Contractor shall be afforded an opportunity to be heard and to offer evidence in support of its appeal. Pending final decision of a dispute hereunder, the Contractor shall proceed diligently with the performance of the contract and in accordance with the Contracting Officer's decision.

ARTICLE 6. INSPECTION. - The Contractor agrees to permit the Contracting Officer or his duly authorized representative to make inspections of the school facilities and courses offered at any reasonable time.

ARTICLE 7. COVENANT AGAINST CONTINGENT FEES. - The Contractor warrants that no person or selling agency has been employed or retained to solicit or secure this contract upon an agreement or understanding for a commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee, excepting bona fide employees or bona fide established commercial or selling agencies maintained by the Contractor for the purpose of securing business. For breach or violation of this warranty the Government shall have the right to annul this contract without liability or in its discretion to deduct

from the contract fee or consideration the full amount of such commission, percentage, brokerage, or contingent fee.

ARTICLE 8. OFFICIALS NOT TO BENEFIT. - No member of or delegate to Congress or resident commissioner shall be admitted to any share or part of this contract or agreement or to any benefit that may arise therefrom, but this provision shall not be construed to extend to this contract if made with a corporation for its general benefit.

ARTICLE 9. ANTIDISCRIMINATION. - In connection with the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees not to discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, creed, color, or national origin; and further agrees to insert the foregoing provision in all subcontracts hereunder except subcontracts for standard commercial supplies or for raw materials.

ARTICLE 10. EIGHT-HOUR LAW OF 1912. - This contract, to the extent that it is of a character specified in the Eight-Hour Law of 1912 as amended (40 U.S. Code 324-326) and is not covered by the Walsh-Healey Public Contracts Act (41 U.S. Code 35-45), is subject to the following provisions and exceptions of said Eight-Hour Law of 1912 as amended, and to all other provisions and exceptions of said law:

No laborer or mechanic doing any part of the work contemplated by this contract, in the employ of the Contractor or any subcontractor contracting for any part of the said work, shall be required or permitted to work more than eight hours in any one calendar day upon such work at the site thereof, except upon the condition that compensation is paid to such laborer or mechanic in accordance with the provisions of this clause. The wages of every such laborer and mechanic employed by the Contractor or any subcontractor engaged in the performance of this contract shall be computed on a basic day rate of eight hours per day; and work in excess of eight hours per day is permitted only upon the condition that every such laborer and mechanic shall be compensated for all hours worked in excess of eight hours per day at not less than one and one-half times the basic rate of pay. For each violation of the requirements of this clause a penalty of five dollars shall be imposed upon the Contractor for each such laborer or mechanic for every calendar day in which such employee is required or permitted to labor more than eight hours upon said work without receiving compensation computed in accordance with this clause; and all penalties thus imposed shall be withheld for the use and benefit of the Government.

ARTICLE 11. CONVICT LABOR. - In connection with the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees not to employ any person undergoing sentence of imprisonment at hard labor.

ARTICLE 12. ASSIGNMENT OF CLAIMS. - No claim under this contract shall be assigned.

ARTICLE 13. DEFINITIONS. - (a) The term "Secretary" as used herein, shall mean the Secretary of the Department, and shall include the Under Secretary and any Assistant Secretary; and the term "his duly authorized representative" shall mean any person (other than the Contracting Officer) or board authorized to act for the Secretary.

(b) Except for the original signing of this contract, and except as otherwise stated herein, the term "Contracting Officer", as used herein, shall include his duly appointed successor or his authorized representative.

(c) In addition, the following terms and definitions shall govern for the purpose of this contract:

"Course" - A series of lectures and/or instructions and/or laboratory periods relating to one particular field of science or learning.
"Curriculum" - The courses as selected by one student for his program of instruction.

ARTICLE 14. ALTERATIONS. - The following alterations have been made in the provisions of this contract:

A large number of questions are arising concerning the use of items on which there are patents issued by the Japanese Government. It is believed desirable that Contractors agree to hold the United States harmless for infringement of any such patents. The language above quoted is in strict conformance with that provided in para 9-105, Section IX, Armed Services Procurement Regulations, 19 May 1948, with selfevident changes.

- (b) An article to cover subcontracting to read as follows, "No portion of this contract may be subcontracted without prior written approval of the Contracting Officer". It has been found that many Contractors subcontract parts of their contracts to small and unqualified subcontractors. It is desirable, especially in Japan, that control of subcontracting rest with the Contracting Officer.
- (c) An article to provide for Termination for the convenience of the Government in the form set forth in par 5-506.1, Section V, Part 5, Joint Procurement Regulations, 1 November 1947. It has been noted that Article 11(e) of Standard Form 32 as now composed states, "such notice of default shall be deemed to have been issued pursuant to the clause of this contract entitled 'Termination for the Convenience of the Government'.....", but there is no article providing for termination for the convenience of the Government.
- (d) A sub-paragraph to Article 11 to read as follows, "(g) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (b) above, if the Contractor fails to deliver the supplies or perform the services within the time specified in this contract, or any extension thereof, the actual damage to the Government for the delay will be impossible to determine, and therefore in lieu thereof the Contractor shall pay to the Government as fixed, agreed, and liquidated damages for

another standard commercial part or component manufactured or supplied by the Contractor) ordered pursuant to this contract, or from specific written instructions given by the Contracting Officer directing a manner of performing the contract not normally utilized by the Contractor."

A large number of questions are arising concerning the use of items on which there are patents issued by the Japanese Government. It is believed desirable that Contractors agree to hold the United States harmless for infringement of any such patents. The language above quoted is in strict conformance with that provided in para 9-105, Section IX, Armed Services Procurement Regulations, 19 May 1948, with selfevident changes.

- (b) An article to cover subcontracting to read as follows, "No portion of this contract may be subcontracted without prior written approval of the Contracting Officer". It has been found that many Contractors subcontract parts of their contracts to small and unqualified subcontractors. It is desirable, especially in Japan, that control of subcontracting rest with the Contracting Officer.
- (c) An article to provide for Termination for the convenience of the Government in the form set forth in par 5-506.1, Section V, Part 5, Joint Procurement Regulations, 1 November 1947. It has been noted that Article 11(e) of Standard Form 32 as now composed states, "such notice of default shall be deemed to have been issued pursuant to the clause of this contract entitled 'Termination for the Convenience of the Government'.....", but there is no article providing for termination for the convenience of the Government.
- (d) A sub-paragraph to Article 11 to read as follows, "(g) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (b) above, if the Contractor fails to deliver the supplies or perform the services within the time specified in this contract, or any extension thereof, the actual damage to the Government for the delay will be impossible to determine, and therefore in lieu thereof the Contractor shall pay to the Government as fixed, agreed, and liquidated damages for
