- 1. The pass in the possession of Mr. Kilgore is one issued by the Office of the Provost Marshal. Tokyo Area, on a standard form used for this purpose to visit "Off Limits" places for a specified period of time when on official business only and when necessary in the performance of duty. The pass states in bold type: "PASS ONLY VALID WHEN ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS".
- 2. Before Public Safety Division made use of these passes and in the interest of caution, the Office of the Tokyo Area Provost Marshal was contacted to ascertain definitely the use to be made of these passes. It was their interpretation that the use or misuse of such passes was the responsibility of the individual, and individuals have been cautioned accordingly. The pass has no validity outside the Tokyo area.
- 3. Public Safety Division hesitated to permit its employees possession of such passes, anticipating possible misuse. It was determined, however, that such passes were necessary in the Tokyo area to properly train police, prison and fire personnel in methods of inspecting restaurants, dance halls, bars, theaters and similar places, off limits to allied personnel. These passes are also used by Public Safety Division fire personnel to permit entry to the area for the purpose of observing Japanese fire fighting operations.
 - 4. Mr. Kilgore's pass was issued 5 January 1947.
