

The party of the first part further agrees to deliver the seeds so contracted for at the prices annexed in good merchantable condition F. O. B. growing station. The party of the second part hereby agrees to accept such seeds in kinds and quantities, and at prices as herein specified, and in the event of a short crop to accept pro rata delivery in full satisfaction of this contract and to pay for the same on the following terms: 60 days acceptance from date of shipment or two per cent. discount for cash in 30 days from date of invoice. Shipment to be made as soon after harvest as possible. It is further understood and agreed to by the party of the second part that the party of the first part gives no warranty, express or implied, as to description, purity, productiveness, or any other matter of any seeds they sell, and that they will not be in any way responsible for same, and that only under these conditions is the above order accepted and booked by them at the low prices named.
