1. It is requested that the undersigned be given authority to issue credentials and badges to agents of the 526th CIC Detachment at this station, and that accountability therefor be resumed by the Commanding Officer of that organization. Such action would facilitate intelligence operations here generally, and would further the G-2 mission in the Ryukyus Command, especially at the present time. An influx of agent replacements is imminent.

2. Nearly two months elapse between the arrival of an agent and the issuance to him of his credentials and his badge. During this period, some of his value is lost to the service, and embarrassment to the agent frequently results.

3. Delegation to the undersigned of the authority to issue credentials will enable all CIC agents of this command to operate with full effectiveness and with greater efficiency from the date they initially report for duty.
