XII. TACTICAL AND OPERATIONAL DATA.

WD-5 Report No. 39

For regular coverage of Marcus Island, Lieut. M. R. COOPER, Jr., in a Squadron Liberator flew North, 13 March 1945, above ten tenths cloud coverage throughout the route. By a lucky chance, Marcus was visible as COOPER arrived and verticals were shot from 20,000 feet through 3 to 4 tenths cumulus, covering the island.

No signs of enemy life or activity were observed.
