JOURNAL OF THE SENATE.

WEDNESDAY 4th March 1835.

The Senate met agreeably to adjournment.

Members present: Messrs. Charles Desbigny president, Boscier, Brownson, Dupré, Hos., Labranche, Lacoste, Moore, Nicholas, Reid, Tête.

Reading of Messages from the House.

A amendment of the house, in the bill entitled "An act to incorporate the Roman Catholic Church of the parish of St. Charles, county of German Coast," was carried in, and the house informed thereof.

"Resolution relative to the location of the School."

"Resolution prohibiting the introduction of bills or resolutions after the 9th March inst."

"An act to incorporate the New-Orleans Gas Light and Banking Company."

"An act granting additional powers to the different parish judges of the state of Louisiana."

"An act granting appropriations to improve the navigation of the rivers West Pearl, Boeuf Chitto, Boeuf Faia, Tangipahoa, Naishaway, Tickfaw and Amite."

"An act to change the boundary line, dividing the parishes of Livingston and St. Helena."

On motion of Mr. Moore, this bill was laid on the table indefinitely.

"Resolution instructing our senators and representatives in congress, to obtain a grant of land, for the benefit of the Atchafalaya Rail Road and Banking Company."

On motion of M. Moore, the rules were dispensed with, and the resolution passed and taken to the house.

M. Lacoste, after leave obtained, introduced a resolution granting leave of absence to Gilbert Leonard, judge of the parish of Plaquemines." Read for the first time.

The president laid before the senate, a communication from the state treasurer, relative to the questions addressed to him by the legislature, with regard to the means of supplying the deficit which would be occasioned by the suppression of gambling licences.

M. Labranche, on the part of the committee of enrollment, reported that he had delivered to the governor for his approval the bill entitled "An act to repeal the act appointing cotton weighers," and

"An act amending the charter of the Commercial Insurance Company."

On motion of M. Boscier, leave of absence was granted to M. Thomas, for a few days.

On motion of M. Nicholas, leave of absence was granted for a few days to M. Tenney.

On motion of M. Moore, the bill which on Monday last had been fixed for the special order, of the day, and entitled "An act to prevent gambling," was taken up and referred to a committee, composed of Messrs. Moore, Nicholas and Brownson. The committee to report to-morrow, and the bill not to lose its order.

Second Reading.

"Resolution relative to outstanding debts."

"An act for the relief of Henry Keane, of the parish of East Baton Rouge."

"Resolution relative to the public lands in the parish of Plaquemines."

"An act to provide for ascertaining and fixing the boundary lines of adjoining parishes." The first and second sections were adopted; and the discussion of the bill suspended.

A message from the house of Representatives, brought by M. A. Cuvalier, their clerk pro tempore, informed the senate that the house had concurred in the bills entitled "An act to repeal so much of an act entitled an act for the organization and discipline of the militia of the state of Louisiana, as divides the militia into two classes," and

"An act to incorporate the firemen's charitable association of New Orleans." That the house had concurred, with amendments, in the bill entitled "an act to regulate the administration of the charity hospital of the city of New Orleans."

The same message requested the concurrence of the senate in the bills and resolution entitled:

"An act to revise as far as it concerns the parishes of St. Bernard, the act entitled "an act to establish courts of criminal jurisdiction, in the parishes comprising the 1st. Judicial District."

"An act to incorporate the Rameau brick manufacturing company, in the parish of Livingston."

"An act further to amend the charter of the West Feliciana rail road company."

"An act granting a co-pension to the state treasurer."

"An act declaring certain offices vacant by the permanent removal of the incumbents from the parish, and providing for the appointment of their successors."

"Resolution requesting the board of public works to cause the Beau Rivage to be examined and surveyed."

A message from the governor, brought by M. A. Fossell, his private secretary, informed the senate, that he approved and signed the bill entitled, "an act to repeal the act appointing cotton weighers," approved March 24th, 1827.

On motion, the senate adjourned until to-morrow, at 10 o'clock A. M.
