# MICHIGAN'S BEAN BRIGADE

Beans are More Important than Bullets in this War Michigan's Bean Broadside Must Not Misfire!

#### PRIME YOUR AMMUNITION

Plant clean, plump, germinable Michigan-grown seed.
Cull out discolored, diseased and immature beans.

#### PLAN A VIGOROUS CAMPAIGN

Against enemies in home fields.
Kill weeds, check diseases, rout the bean maggot.

#### FIT SEED-BED THOROUGHLY

Firm with roller to break clods and fill air spaces.

Follow roller with harrow to save moisture.

### DISC AND HARROW AT WEEKLY INTERVALS

Kill weeds as they germinate.

Lessen labor of later cultivation by thorough fitting.

### FERTILIZE FOR BUMPER CROP

Phosphates increase yields and hasten maturity.

Complete fertilizers also effective.

### PLANT ON WELL WARMED SEED BED

Planting time ranges from June 1st to 25th.

Plant three pecks per acre in rows 28 or 32 inches apart.

### CULTIVATE FREQUENTLY

Shallow after thirty days to avoid root pruning.

Do not cultivate wet plants. Disease spores are easily spread.
