

\$150,000 to build about 230 miles of line to serve 689 members in Craighead, Crittenden and Poinsett Counties. The project previously has been allotted \$565,000 to build 603 miles of line to serve 1,908 members in the above mentioned and Greene, Lawrence and Independence Counties, and \$3,500 to finance house wiring and plumbing installations.

\$196,000, of which \$46,000 will be used to build about 28 miles of line to serve 39 members in Bonner County, and \$150,000 will be used for the construction of a generating plant.
