2. Application referred to in paragraph 1b above is approved subject to the following conditions:

a. As agents of the companies listed in paragraph 1b above, Suzuki and Hashimoto, Inc. will limit their activities to the following:

- (1) Survey damaged goods insured through non-Japanese companies;



- (2) Determine value of any losses and report such values to the insuring companies for purposes of effecting final settlement with the policyholder;
- (3) Survey salvage value of partial losses and in the event of total loss payment, arrange for acceptance and disposition of salvage for the insuring company.
- (4) Examine condition, method of loading and packing of cargo to determine if they meet with usual standards of insuring company;
- (5) Issue to policyholders standard agreement forms customary to the business and necessary before survey and adjustment can be finalized in disputed cases;
- (6) Handle all final documents prior to acceptance of claims payment as well as final payment made by the insuring company;
- (7) Accept shipping advice on cargo covered by the insuring company.

b. Each agency agreement entered into between Suzuki and Hashimoto Inc. and a foreign insurance company will be subject to approval of General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.

c. Fees established due Suzuki and Hashimoto Inc. for services rendered the foreign insurance companies will be kept current and made through remittance facilities established in foreign banks licensed by the Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers.


1. Reference is Central Liaison and Coordination Memorandum No. 3560 (LO 3809 AD/CU) dated 14 October 1948, subject: Application Concerning the Rights of Repatriated Japanese to Underwrite New Stocks. This memorandum requests approval for the purchase of new stock from companies increasing their capital by repatriates whose presently-owned stock in the same companies has been left abroad or surrendered upon entering Japan.

2. Application attached to reference memorandum is approved insofar as the repatriates who surrendered their stock certificates upon entering Japan are concerned. The right to purchase new stock conferred by the Japanese Commercial Code shall be extended to those repatriates:






