This is in reply to the Office letter of January 12, 1938 with regard to the written consent to the use of the portraits forming a feature of the label.

Withdrawal of this requirement is believed to be in order for the reason that this application is itself in the name of Hal Roach Studios, Inc. Inasmuch as the Studios has applied as proprietor, and since the Studios has the contract rights with the individuals forming "Our Gang" there seems to be no necessity for requiring any further written consent in the file of this application.

If the application were not made in the name of the Studios, there would perhaps be proper ground for requiring this written consent but it is of course a matter of common knowledge that the "Our Gang" feature is presented only by Hal Roach Studios, and since they have the commercial rights to the reproduction of the pictures of the gang, and since they apply here as proprietors it seems clear that there is no necessity for further consent to be filed.

Applicant also wishes to acknowledge a recent oral interview with the Examiner in charge of this appli-

cation, at which time these facts were presented, and as a result of which applicant received the understanding that the application would be forthwith allowed. Such action is respectfully requested.
