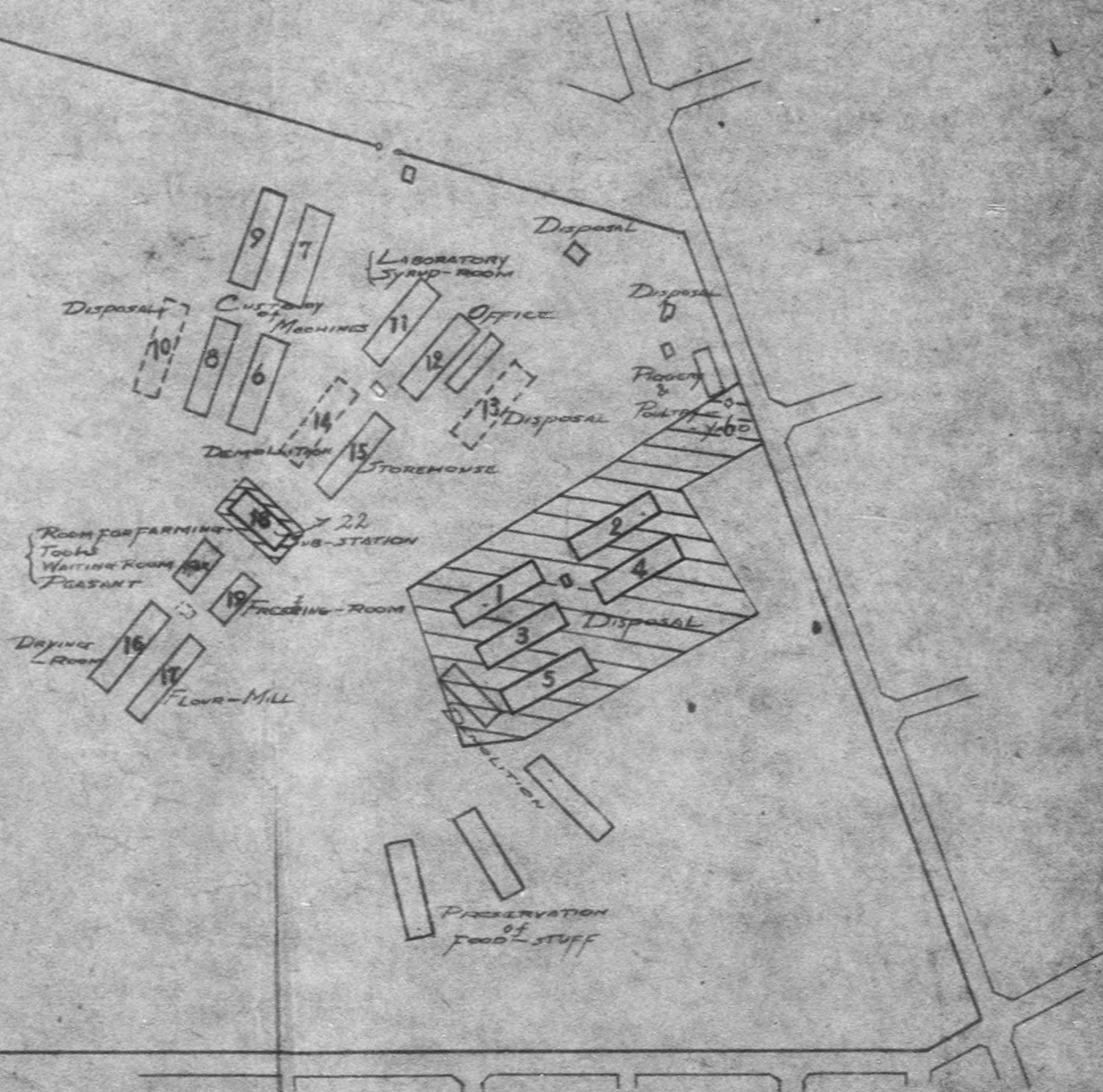


Y.E.W. KAVAGOE PLANT

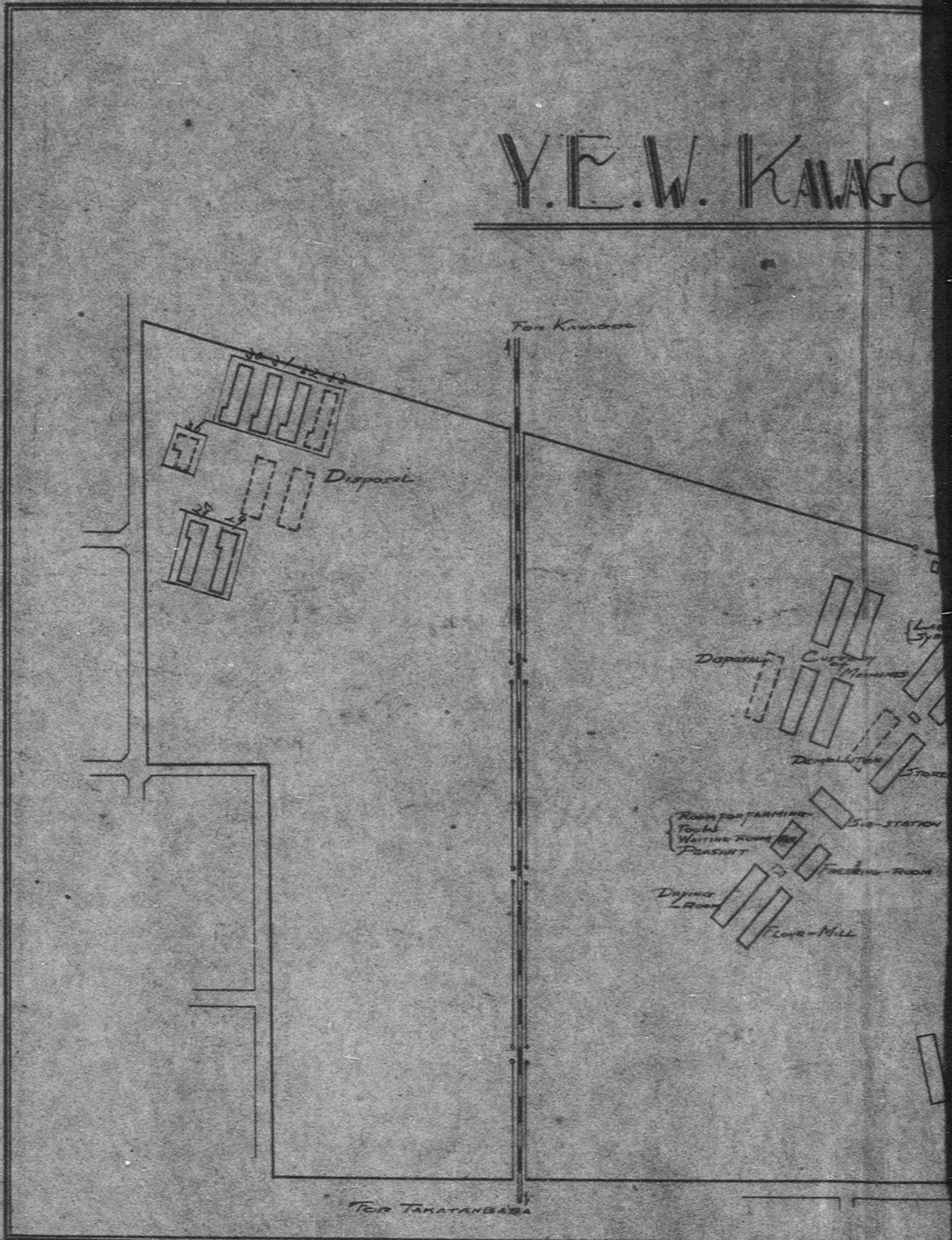

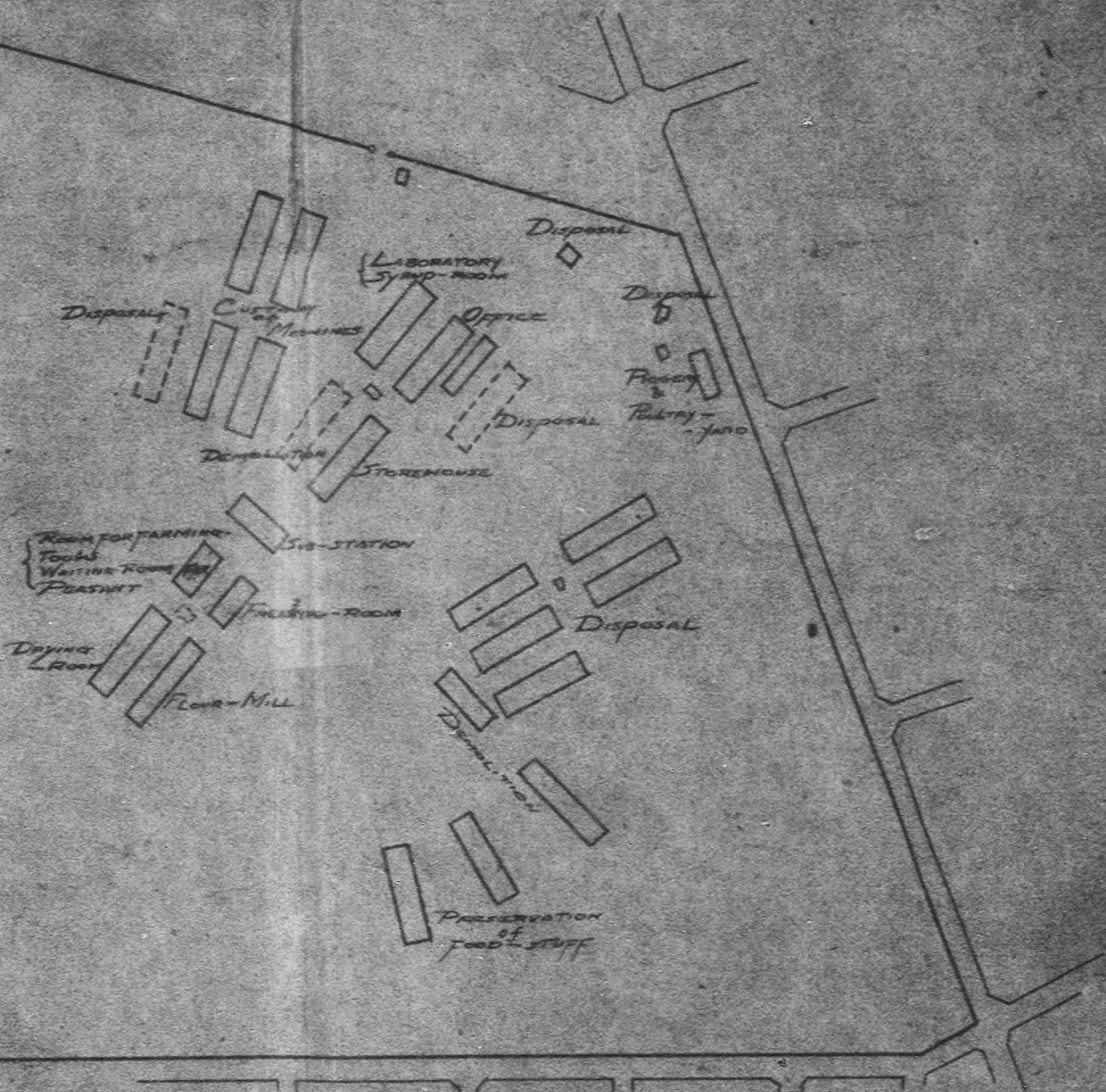


Y.E.W. KAWAGOE PLANT
