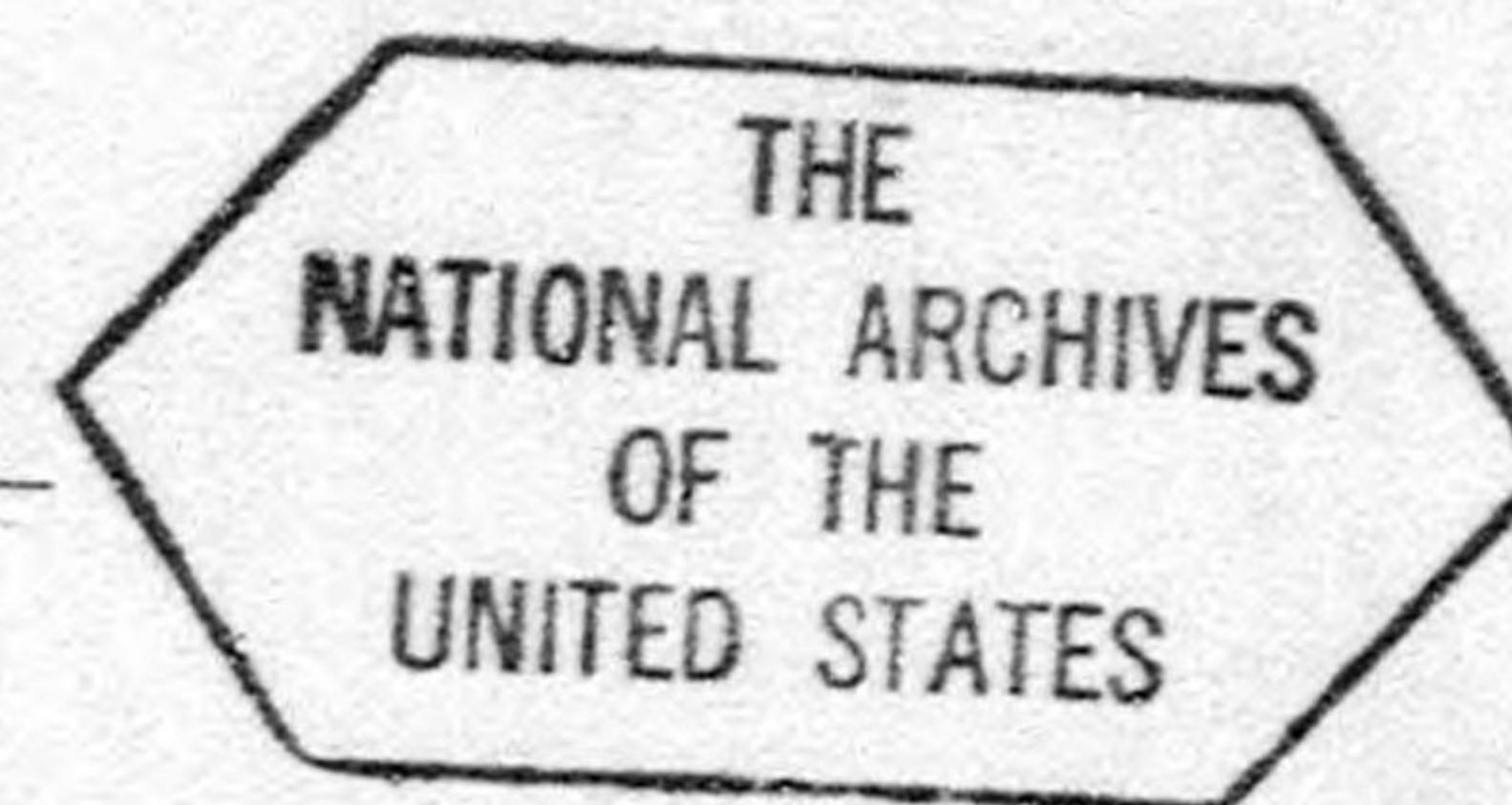




CHART OF MAIN MEMBERS OF

OFFICIAL FUNCTION OF THE
PERIOD WITHIN PURVIEW

(Regulation pertaining
to official duties)

MANAGING DIRECTOR- Represents the firm and exercises control over all business.

DIRECTOR: EDITOR IN CHIEF- Occupies a higher rank than the director, chief of the editorial department and decides the highest principle of making the newspaper

DIRECTOR: CHIEF OF THE EDITORIAL DEPARTMENT- Consulting with the editor-in-chief designs the making of the newspaper and also is responsible of personnel administration in the department.

EDITORIAL DEPARTMENT

ADJUSTING SECTION- In charge of making the newspapers daily, selecting the manuscripts that comes from all sections.

ECONOMIC SECTION- Obtains articles of or from companies, economic control organizations, economic relations, government offices and businessmen stating the actual economical condition.

SOCIAL SECTION- With the exception of political and economical problems on the paper, looks after all social phenomena such as events relating with human living and matters of investigation.

COMMUNICATION SECTION- Manages all communication affairs between the Tokyo Branch Office and other local branches.

PREFECTURAL MUNICIPAL ADMINISTRATION SECTION- Makes articles concerning local administration such as the prefectures and the cities.

DIRECTOR: CHIEF OF THE BUSINESS DEPARTMENT:- Supervises and manages affairs concerning the Advertisement Section, Sales section, General affairs section, and the intendance section.

BUSINESS DEPARTMENT

PLANNING SECTION - Plan and executes all undertaking programme under auspices of the firm.

ADVERTISEMENT SECTION - Manages all affairs concerning newspaper advertisement.

SALES SECTION - Manages all affairs concerning the selling of the newspapers.

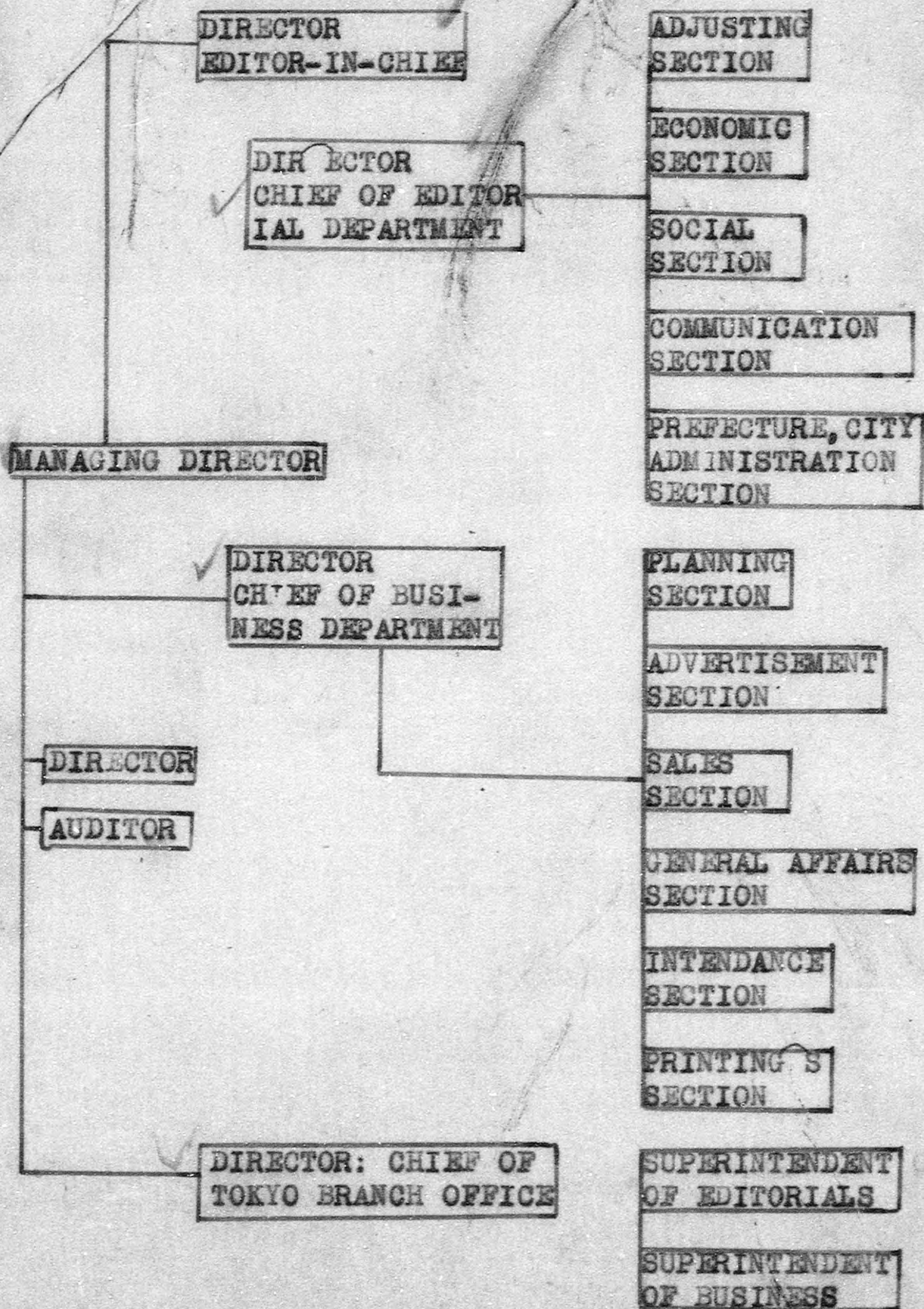
GENERAL AFFAIRS SECTION - In charge of all routine works that does not belong to any other section.

INTENDANCE SECTION - In charge of all affairs concerning intendance.

PRINTING SECTION - In charge of all printings of the firm.

DIRECTOR: CHIEF OF THE TOKYO BRANCH OFFICE- Stay in Tokyo and exercises control over all business concerning this branch.
