Bills for Garden Seed, amounting to \$25 or more, are due June 1, irrespective of date of purchase, or a discount of 1 per cent per month will be allowed on the unexpired time when paid before maturity. 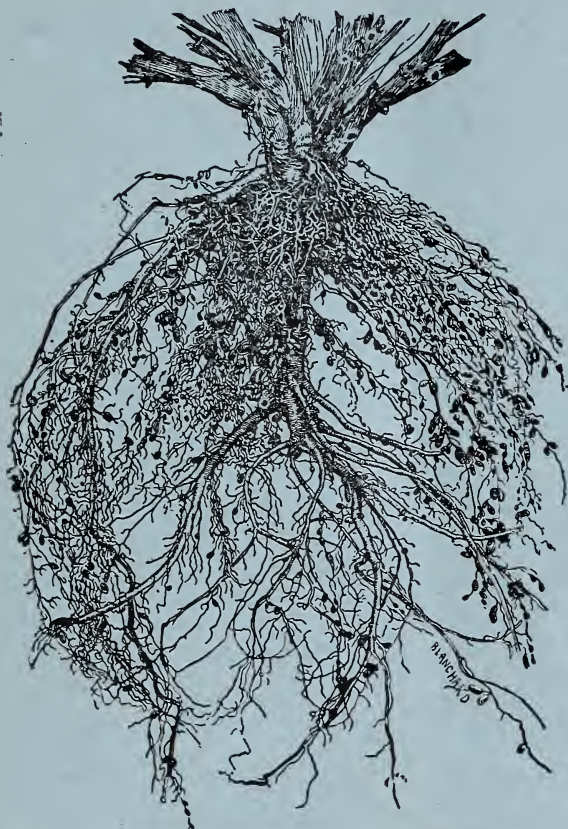
