1. Reparations inventoried equipment at the Obucho and Kitaikeda factories of Dai Nippon Tanatsu K.K., plant code numbers 32-41 and 32-42 respectively, was transferred to the company's No. 5 factory, Kishiwada City, plant code number 32-40, in October, 1947.

2. The Kitaikeda and Kishiwada factories were subsequently released from reparations custody so as to permit utilization of the facilities in the civilian economy.

3. The following electric transformers were authorized by this headquarters to be temporarily retained at the released locations to provide power transmission facilities until replacement transformers could be obtained:

- a. At the Obucho Plant: 32-41-9, 10, 11, and 12.
- b. At the Kitaikeda Plant: 32-42-14, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45 and 46.

4. The Dai Nippon Company has repeatedly requested that the transformers be permitted to remain at the dispersed locations, claiming that replacements are not available from normal supply sources. Investigation by this headquarters has revealed that this claim is without basis, and that transformers of the types required are available for purchase.

5. The items cite paragraph 3 above will therefore be transferred to the No. 5 plant of the Dai Nippon Tanatsu Company and placed together with the other 32-41 and 32-42 equipment stored therein. The transfer will be completed within thirty (30) days from this date.

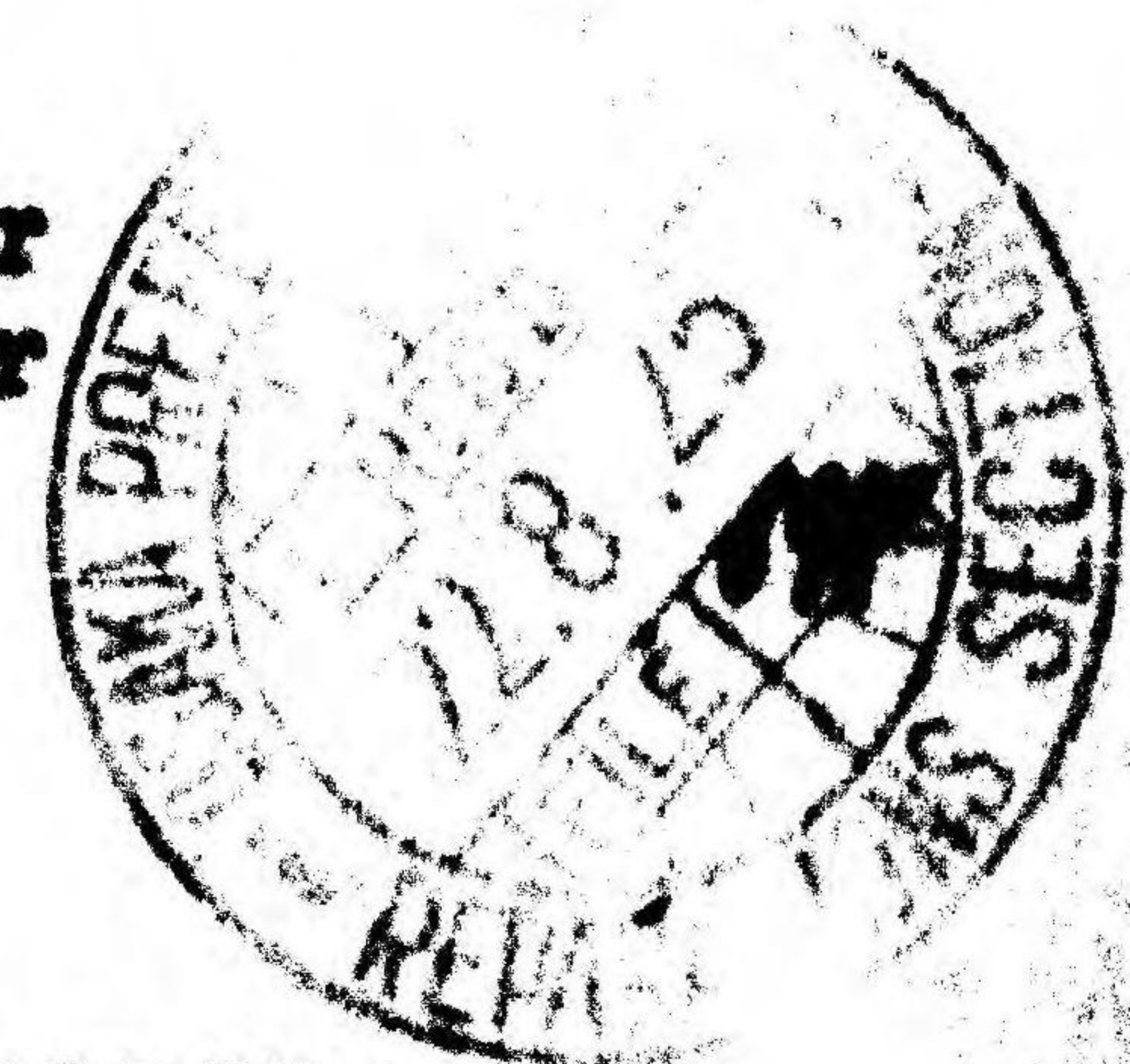

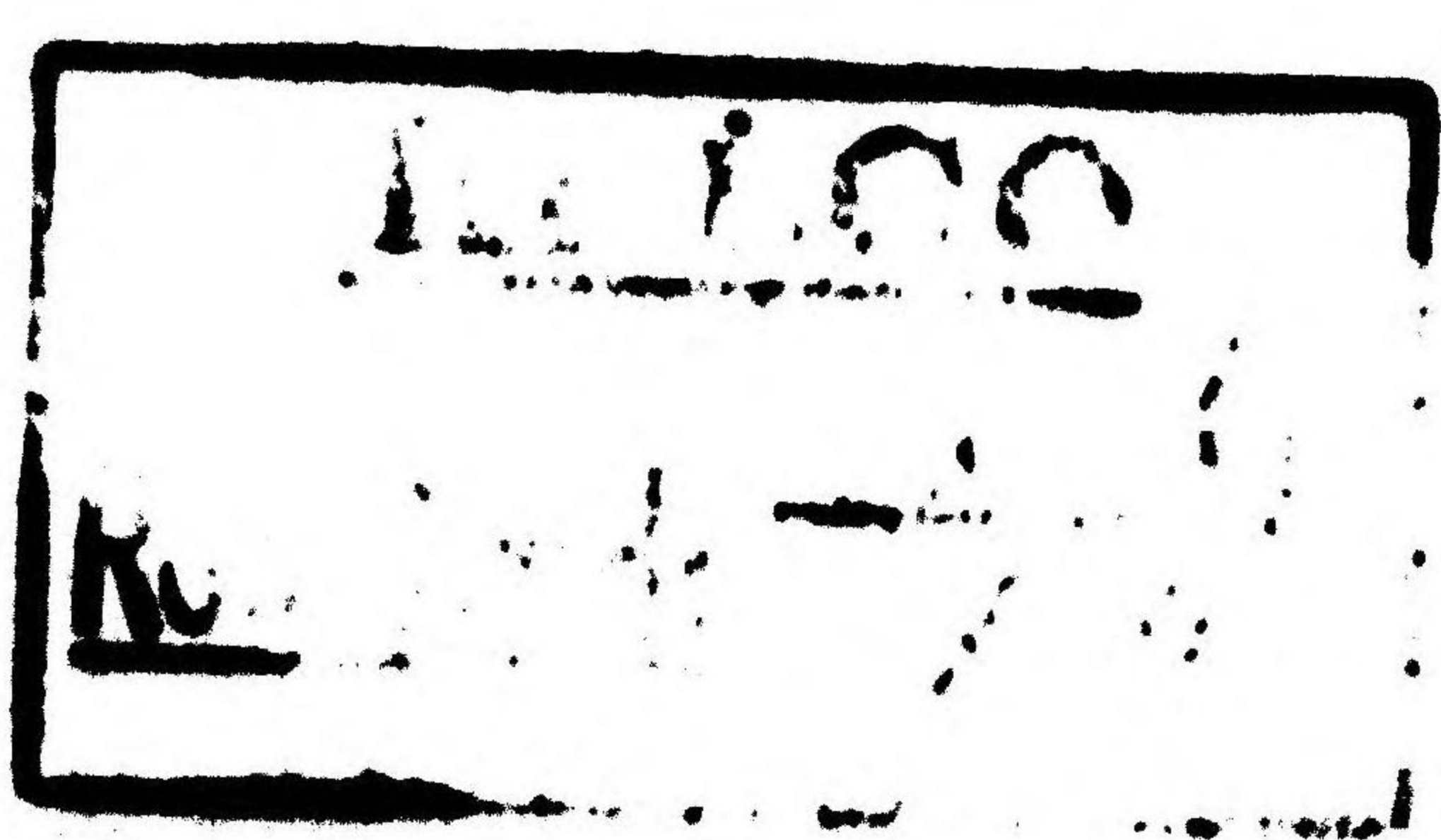

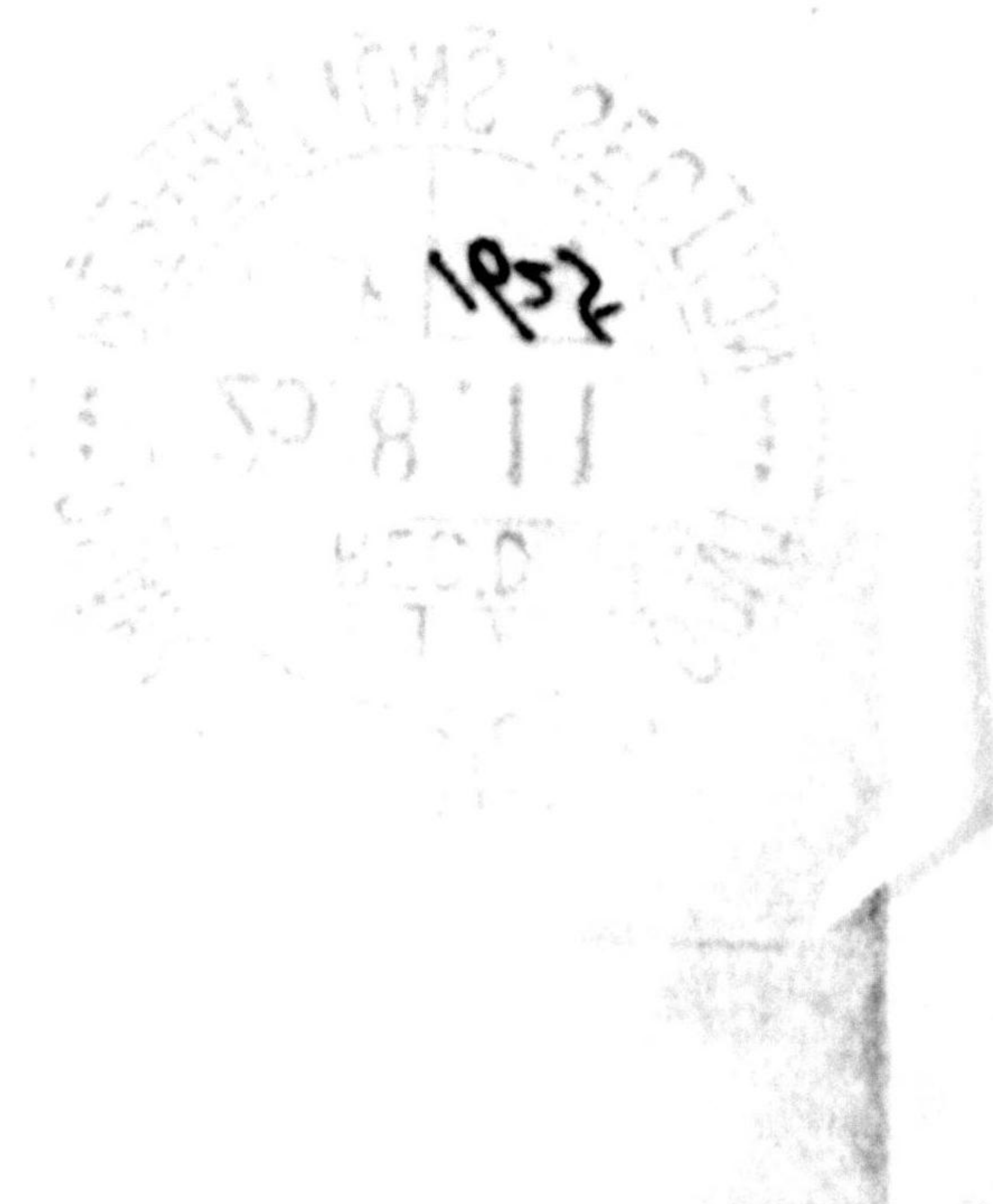
