Feedback on movement brand guidelines update February 2022




General information


The proposed updates to the Brand Guidelines make them more comprehensive than the current version on meta, with more tools, templates and resources


The proposed changes to the Brand portal on Meta wiki make it easier to navigate and find what I'm looking for


The portal language is easy to read, understand and translate.


The Figma logo and social-media templates are easy to use and accessible to even non-professional designers.

Resource	Comment
Brand guidelines portal	The "black color links" are very confusing. We use "blue color links" everywhere else in the projects.
Brand guidelines portal	For the Imagery tab - perhaps move the "Credits" section higher (it's crucial!) and add it to the Table of Contents.
Brand guidelines portal	I did not find any way of creating video branding for Wikipedia and Wikimedia content
Brand guidelines portal	Resources can be one of the menus added on the top navigation

Resource	Comment
Brand guidelines portal	I could not find the existing contents that are linked from https://meta.wikimedia.org/wiki/Brand#Assets within this redesign. It is unclear whether useful links to things like https://meta.wikimedia.org/wiki/Brand/Letterhead are being eliminated, or have yet to be added.
Brand guidelines portal	For the color palettes - please provide a plaintext version, so that we can "select, copy, and paste" the #hex codes elsewhere, instead of having to manually read & type them (which will lead to more frequent errors). Brand guidelines portal	video branding for Wikipedia and Wikimedia content would be a key way for branding and reaching out to more people through social media platforms

Resource	Comment
Presentation template	Would be great if there was a generic Wikimedia logo without the wordmark "foundation" or a certain chapter's name.
Presentation template	Some users may not prefer the Sans Serif and Montserrat fonts
Brand guidelines portal	It would be good to mention that using the Black logo is recommended while affiliates are free not to use it.
Brand guidelines portal	There is a template on Figma to add your own affiliate mark as a logo but the portal has no information about when is this recommended.
