NEW SCIENCE FOR CANADA.

Forestry as a science is claiming a great deal of attention in educational circles at present. A historic event at Queen's University last week, was a series of lectures on the subject, delivered by that well-known American expert, Prof. B. E. Fernow, of Cornell.

Considering that lumbering ranks second only to agriculture among the great industries of this country, it is almost surprising to reflect that so little attention has been paid to the science of forestry by government and the public.

That Canada's heritage of standing timber is greater than that of any other country, and that the total resources of Russia and the United States (second and third, respectively) are together not slightly in excess of the Dominion's forest wealth, are established facts.
