EXPLANATORY NOTE

Illustrated articles are denoted by an asterisk (*); book notices by a dagger (†).

This index is made comprehensive but concise. Pains are taken to bring together matter belonging to the same subject, so that when a reader looks up an article, he will be cited to related data. Series of simple page numbers, following names of mines or companies, usually refer to news notes. When minor references are numerous, as in the case of "Anaconda," they are sometimes separately designated as "Various notes." With a major entry or series of entries, may be placed several minor ones, relating to the same subject in order that its history may be followed. If the author's name is known, it is the simplest means of reference. Productions are indexed under names of metals and countries or states. The mere juxtaposition of a mineral and geographical name usually signifies an output, but may cover other statistical or news matter. Not all news are indexed but a liberal selection of them is made.
