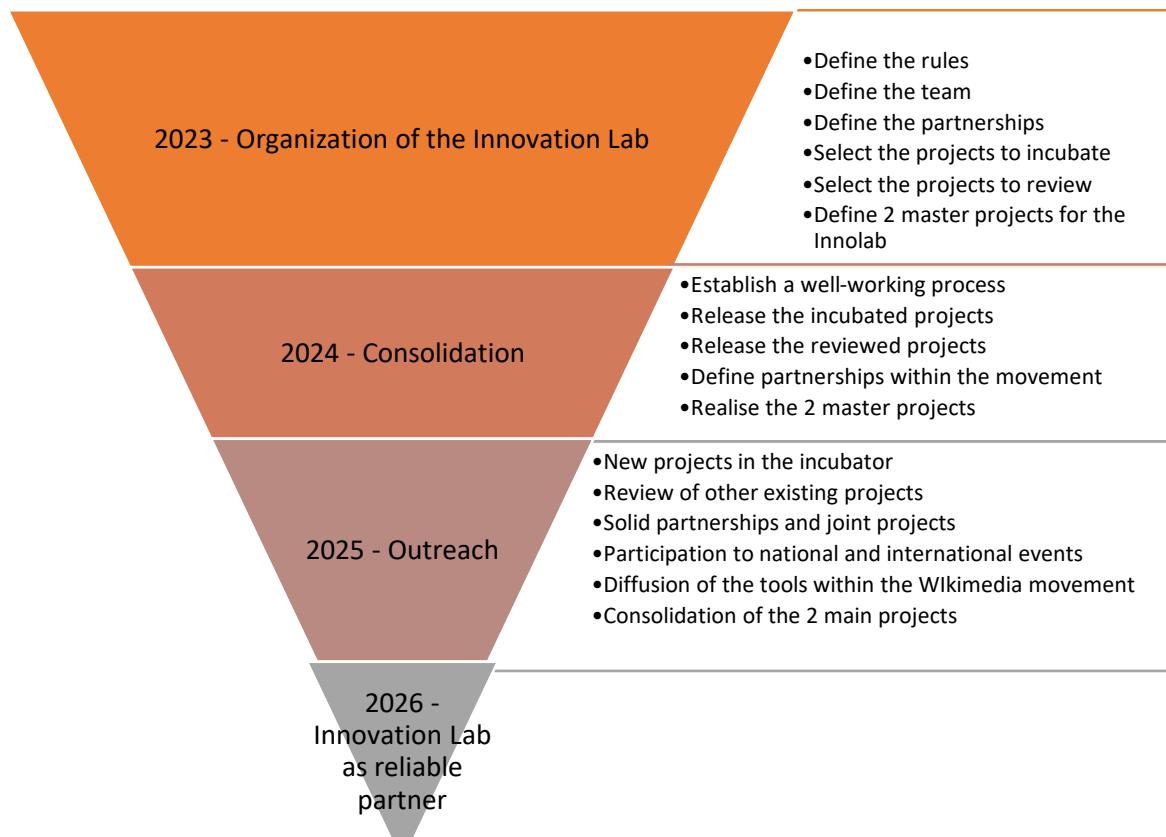


Innovation Programme 2024

Aims for 2024

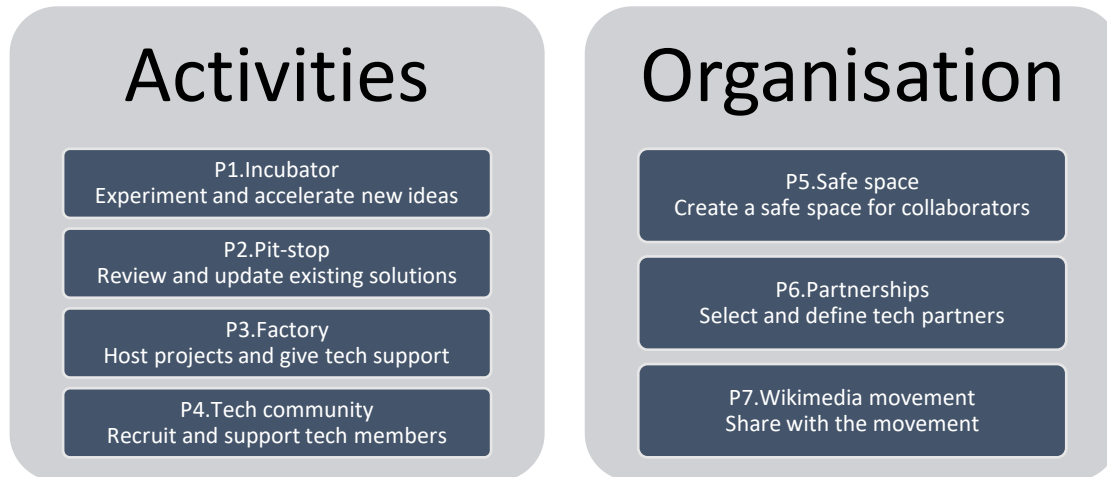
Activities

- In-house knowledge (P5 and P6).

- Build Innovation Partnership Management (P6).
- Define the organisation (P5 and P6).
- Define the IT structure (P5 and P6).
- Expand cross-Chapter collaboration and knowledge sharing (P7).



Master projects of the “factory”:

- **Climate change - Wikiklima:** Scientific approach to the problem of climate change giving more qualitative content to Wikimedia projects and sensitizing the community about this topic.
- **Knowledge Equity – Science in Wikimedia projects:** Project to increase the quality of content in Wikimedia projects related to science and technical topics.
- **Project translator:** Provide the community with a tool to help in case of multilingual online meetings.
- **Project AI:** Project to investigate the impact of AI in Wikimedia projects and the potential activities that can benefit from this new technology.
