
Innovation Programme 2024

Aims for 2024


Activities

- Climate change Wikiklima: Scientific approach to the problem of climate change giving more qualitative content to Wikimedia projects and sensitizing the community about this topic.
- **Knowledge Equity Science in Wikimedia projects**: Project to increase the quality of content in Wikimedia projects related to science and technical topics.
- **Project translator**: Provide the community with a tool to help in case of multilingual online meetings.
- **Project AI**: Project to investigate the impact of AI in Wikimedia projects and the potential activities that can benefit from this new technology.
