







Nineteenth Century Post Offices near Lake Weir, Florida

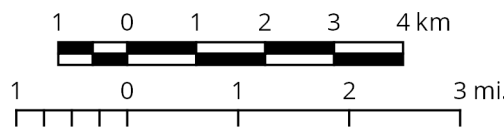
● Post Office, Original Name

Notes: Bellview was renamed, "Belleview," in 1884. Long Swamp was renamed, "Whitesville," in 1878; it was again renamed, in 1887, as "Summerfield." Lake Ware was renamed, "Lake Weir," in 1880. Foster Park was renamed, "Weirsdale," in 1892. Eastlake did not become Eastlake Weir" until 1938.
