MINISTERIAL ORDINANCE

Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 99

October 4, 1950

In accordance with the provisions of Article 23 paragraph 2 and Article 40 paragraph 3 of the Ministry of Finance Establishment Law (Law No. 144 of 1949) and for the purpose of enforcing the same Law, the Ministerial Ordinance for Partial Amendments to the Ministry of Finance Organization Regulations shall be established as follows:

Ministerial Ordinance for Partial Amendments to the Ministry of Finance Organization Regulations

The Ministry of Finance Organization Regulations (Ministry of Finance Ordinance No. 37 of 1949) shall be partially amended as follows:

In Article 12 item (11), "Matters concerning liaison with Finance Bureaus and Finance Offices" shall be amended as "Liaison with Finance Bureaus."

In Article 51 item (1), next to "the Finance Bureau" shall be added "(excluding the Finance Offices)."

In Article 52 item (6), next to "Contracts" shall be added "(Law No. 60 of 1946)."

Article 149 shall be amended as follows: (Work of Melting Section)

Article 149. The Melting Section shall take charge of the melting of material bullions and the melting down of old coins, etc.

In Article 150 item (2) shall be made item (3) and next to item (1) shall be added the following one item:

(2) Press-rolling of material bullions;

In Attached Table No. 7 Names and Location of Guard Posts of Custom-House and of Branch Customs, part of Moji Custom-House item of Saga Guard Post of Izuhara Branch Customs, "Nida-mura" shall be amended as "Mine-mura."

In Attached Table No. 9 Names of Taxation Offices, their Locations and Areas of Jurisdiction, part of Nagoya Tax Administration Bureau item of Gifu-Kita Taxation Office, "(excluding the

area belonging to former Kano-machi)" shall be amended as "(excluding the area under the charge of the Gifu-Minami Taxation Office),"; in item of Gifu-Minami Taxation Office of the same part, next to "Kano-machi" shall be added ", former Ichihashi-mura, former Uzura-mura and former Akanabe-mura."

Supplementary Provision:

This Ministerial Ordinance shall come into force as from the day of its promulgation. Provided, however, the amended provisions of Articles 149 and 150 shall apply as from September 22, 1950 and the amended provisions of items of Gifu-Kita Taxation Office and Gifu-Minami Taxation Office of part of Nagoya Tax Administration Bureau of Attached Table No. 9 Names of Taxation Offices, their Locations and Areas of Jurisdiction shall apply as from August 20, 1950.


