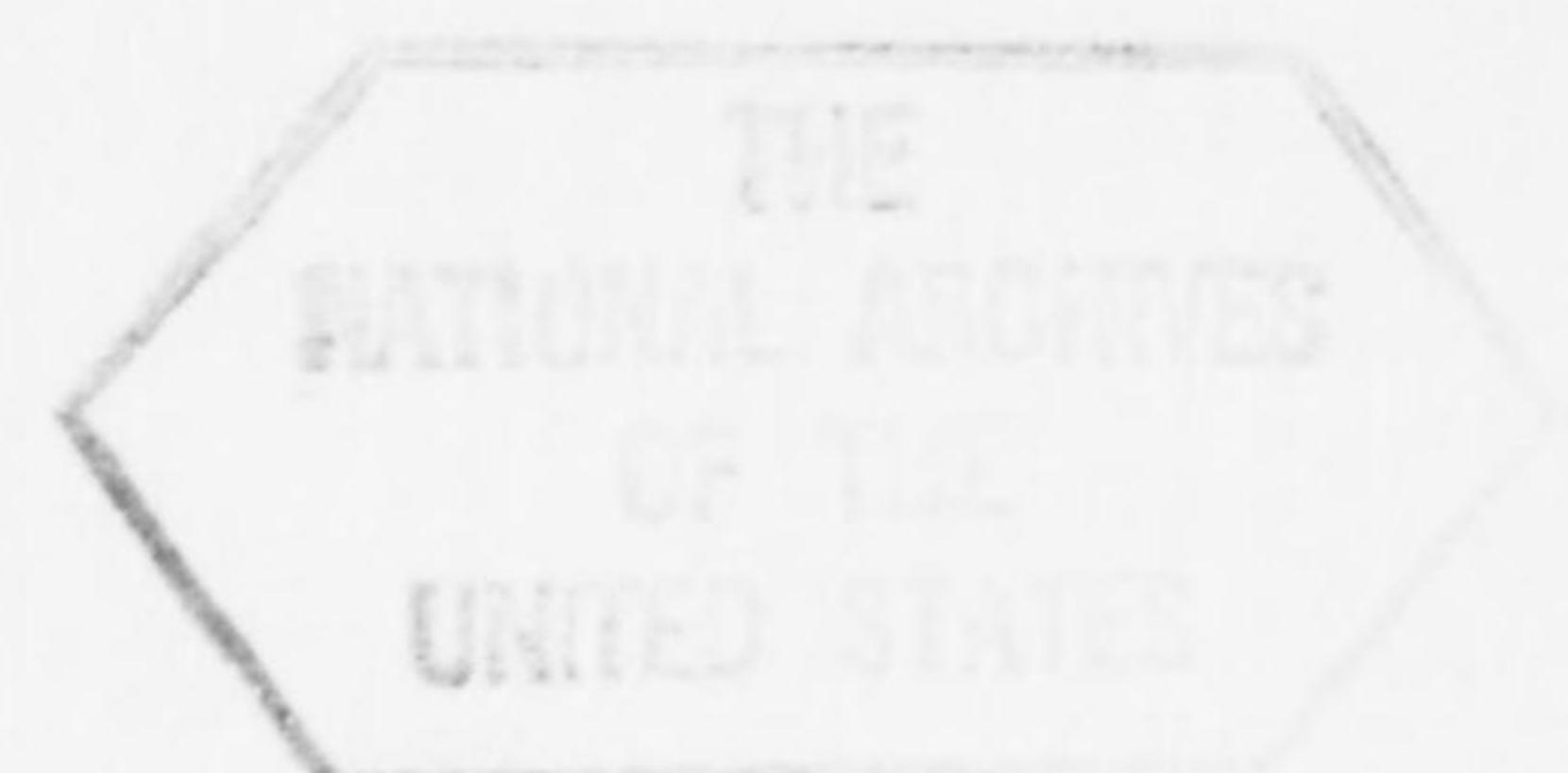

The proposal to conduct a small loan business by the Government for the purpose of making advances to those persons not in a position to obtain credit from banks or other private credit organizations is an invasion of the private banking and loaning business which involves a policy question to be carefully considered by the Sections of SCAP concerned. It is difficult to see how the proposed corporation could make sound loans to persons who are unable to obtain credit from private lending agencies, therefore it is reasonable to assume that the operations of the corporation will result in a loss to be paid out of public funds.

2. The bill proposes an elaborate organization with authority to establish branch offices in each prefecture. In addition it is authorized to issue powers of attorney to private financial institutions so that they can act as agents to perform a part of its business. In the interest of economy and to avoid the establishment of additional branches of the national government throughout the country, careful consideration should be given to the feasibility of making all loans through existing private banking facilities.

3. In Article 10(3) 1 the words "Finance Bureau" should be revised to read "Financial Affairs Bureau" to comply with the proposed re-organization of the ESB.

4. Article 10 (3) 2 should specify whether or not the four representatives are to be government officials.

5. In Article 18 it is recommended that a ceiling be placed on the amount of individual loans to insure the objectives of the law. A ceiling should also be placed on the interest rate by law.

6. Article 19, paragraph (3) should be revised to eliminate "Maximum size of loans, rate of interest".

7. Article 28, Para. (2) contains a broad authority to issue orders. Whether or not the Minister must consult the Council (See Article 10, Para 1) prior to the issuance of such orders is not clear. Furthermore, in view of the proposal to impose an administrative fine not exceeding thirty thousand yen for a violation of such orders (See Article 32, Item 5) the power must be clearly defined and limited in scope.

8. Article 29 appears unnecessary. Since the officers are in the National Public Service (See Art. 17) they are subject to dismissal for reasons set forth in the National Public Service Law.

9. Article 32 and 33 are objected to. The imposition of Administrative fines, especially in such large amounts is a dangerous device. If penalties are desired for the offenses listed, there is no reason why regular penal provisions can not be written.

10. Article 34 leaves to Cabinet Order matters of substantive law. The law should state which laws and orders shall apply mutatis mutandis.

11. In Article 45 the transfer of the employees of the People's Bank and of the Pension Bank to the new corporation should be passed upon by Sections of SCAP concerned with personnel and budgetary matters.

12. In Article 49 the authorization left to Cabinet Order should be limited to "necessary administrative and procedural matters."

13. In the supplementary provisions, para. (2) the date of repeal of two laws is to be the date of establishment of the corporation. According to Article 41 an establishment committee is to be appointed which is to take steps necessary to form the corporation. After capital is paid in the President, Vice-President, Directors and Auditors are to register the corporation. The contemplated procedure will mean that the effective date

of the repeal of two laws depends upon the acts of minor officials, which is highly undesirable. Some certain future date should be fixed in the law, or if necessary the effective date can be left to Cabinet Order with a time limit fixed within which the Cabinet must act.

Subsequent to receipt of attached "2nd Draft" bill, the Ministry of Finance submitted to this Section, copy of "Errata, The People's Finance Corporation Law (Draft)", which has also been submitted formally to CLCO. Attached copy of draft bill has been corrected in accordance with Errata, Article 46 has been re-numbered to Article 45 (omitted from Errata), and some grammatical and punctuation errors have been corrected.

2. Officials of the Ministry of Finance have explained that it is anticipated that the Corporation to be established by this law will establish a Separation Allowance program for the employees of the Corporation similar to the one in effect for the national public servants and that such program will be the basis for applying Articles 39 and 40.

3. The objectionable features contained in previous drafts of this proposed bill, which provided for the continuance of the present practice of mortgaging pensions to the Pension Bank, and which were the basis for the objection entered by check sheet dated 7 September 1948, have been eliminated from the attached draft bill. 

1. No legal objection is made to the introduction of subject bill in the Diet.
  2. However, as far as the policy is concerned, according to ESS/Anti-Trust Division, the increase of certain fines in Articles 20, 21 and 22 was based upon an arbitrary determination by the Japanese. In order to maintain uniformity of penalties such increases should all be based upon an index of increased living costs, unless some other factor is involved of specific importance in particular cases.
  3. No opinion is expressed concerning other policy questions involved in the bill, which relate to changes in the composition of the Committee, the manner of reporting by designated companies to the Committee, and the powers of the Committee to require attendance of certain witnesses, make inquiries or require presentation of certain records.
  4. In Article 14 it is suggested that the phrase "A joint-stock company as may be prescribed..." be changed to "Any joint-stock company which is designated..." in order to make clear that only designated companies need to submit reports.

Information reaching ESS discloses that the figures cited in the "Reasons for Amendment" appended to the attached bill concerning average production cost and black market selling prices of saccharine and dulcin may be in error. Consequently, a reduction of the commodity tax from 6,000 yen to 2,000 yen per kilogram of saccharine and dulcin may involve an appreciable revenue decrease rather than an increase as alleged in the attached argument.

b. The tax on saccharine and dulcin was cut by 50% as recently as 20 December 1948, for reasons similar to those advanced in the present argument. It has not been demonstrated that a further reduction in tax is desirable either from a revenue standpoint or from the overall economic recovery standpoint.
