CRUCY, ADRIAN AND SISTER LUCIE CALHOUN TIMES JULY 22, 1886

ADRIAN CRUCY and his sister Lucie, the last of a devoted French family that had lived for many years in one house on Lexington avenue, New York, were found dead in their home a few days since, having committed suicide by shooting themselves. Adrian was a commission merchant, fiftyone years old; his sister was fifty-nine. No reason was assigned for the act.
