A. Fukuoka Prefectural Ordinance No. 70

Promulgated 3 August 46

Art. 1

Dentists are prohibited from rendering any treatments to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

In case the dentist is requested by force to render treatment to United States Army Personnel, he is obligated to report promptly to the Provost Marshal through the nearest Police Station.

Art. 3

Those violating the above rules shall be subjected to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: The above Ordinance shall be in force from the date of promulgation.

B. Saga Prefectural Ordinance No. 64

Promulgated on 13 August 46

Art. 1

Dentists under any circumstances, are prohibited from rendering dental treatment to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

Those violating the above regulation shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: The Prefectural Ordinance shall be put in force from the date of its' promulgation.

C. Oita Prefectural Ordinance No. 34

Promulgated and enforced on 16 August 46

Rules concerning the Supervision of Dentists in Oita Prefecture

Art. 1

Dentists are forbidden from rendering treatment to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

In case the dentist is requested by force to render treatment to United States Army Personnel, he is obligated to report promptly either to the nearest Police Station or United States Military Government Authorities.

Art. 3

Those violating the above rules shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: This ordinance shall be in force from the date of its' promulgation.

D. Miyazaki Prefectural Ordinance No. 50

Promulgated on 25 July 46

Art. 1

Dentists, under any circumstances, are prohibited from rendering treatment to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

Those violating the above regulation shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: The above Ordinance shall be put in force from the date of its' promulgation.

E. Kumamoto Prefectural Ordinance No.

Promulgated on 13 August 46

Art. 1

Dentists are forbidden to render treatment to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

The dentist, in case compelled by force to render treatment to United States Army Personnel, should report promptly to the competent Police Station or United States Military Government Authorities.

Art. 3

Those violating the rules above regulated shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: The above Ordinance shall be put in force from the date of its' promulgation.

F. Nagasaki Prefectural Ordinance No. 52

Promulgated 9 August 46

Art. 1

Japanese dentists other than those employed by United States Armed Force's personnel in authorized Dental Clinics are prohibited from rendering treatment to United States Army Personnel.

Art. 2

Those committed of violation of the above regulation shall be subjected to a fine of not more than fifty (50) Yen or held in detention.

Bye-Law: The above Prefectural Ordinance shall be in force from the date of its' promulgation.
