This report consists of two separate documents, summarized respectively as follows:

Field Military Police Duties and Situation Problems  
(Doc 1481)

This item consists of extracts from a 125-page mimeographed manual, which apparently was disseminated in connection with a course given by 2d Lt ISHII of the Japanese Military Police. The sections presented here give an elementary introduction to the Japanese concept of secret warfare, with some simple situation problems for military police. The latter may be based on actual events at Kuala Lumpur, Federated Malay States.

## I. EXAMPLES OF SECRET WARFARE

(TN: "Secret Warfare" is a term loosely used to cover those activities short of actual armed fighting which aid in the weakening and disruption of the enemy. These include secret negotiations, secret diplomacy, espionage, fifth-column activities, psychological warfare, counterintelligence, etc.)

### A. Examples of Secret Diplomacy by the Great Powers against Japan

1. Unfair reduction of Japan's armament at such conferences as the Washington Conference.
2. Through immigration laws, making difficult the solution of Japan's population problem.
3. Confusion of Japanese thought by infusing various types of internationalism, especially the bad elements of Communism and Liberalism.
4. Measures by the white race to use the colored races surrounding Japan to block her development. Example: China's anti-Japanese actions, resulting from Anglo-Russian aid.
5. The recent American economic blockage of raw materials and technical knowledge, directed against Japan.
6. Suspicious undercover activities in connection with the recent high accident rate and raw material shortages in Japan.
7. Repeated British economic machinations in connection with the fall in value of Chinese currency during the present China Incident.

### B. Examples of German Secret Warfare

1. Securing freedom for military action against England and France through a non-aggression pact with Russia.
2. Insidious Nazi ideological activity behind the bloodless occupation of Austria and Czechoslovakia.
3. Undercover ideological and diplomatic activity behind the blitzkrieg in Norway and Denmark.
4. Secret political activity to instigate the surrender of the Belgian Army.

II. METHODS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE

Psychological warfare may be divided into:

Active methods - propaganda, intrigue  
Passive methods - thought control

A. Propaganda

Propaganda is a means of influencing the enemy by disseminating information [tending] to create a condition favorable to us and unfavorable to him.

B. Intrigue

Intrigue is designed to destroy the enemy's political and social systems, and to cause the internal collapse of the country by breaking the enemy psychologically. During time of war other activities, such as disrupting the enemy's military leadership and operations, are possible.

A striking example of British and American intrigue is the recent event in Italy where Marshal Badoglio assumed the power relinquished by Premier Mussolini, and joined the anti-Axis nations. Germany's collapse in the first World War was also a result of intrigue.

C. Thought Control

Its purpose is to prevent our people from being affected psychologically by intelligence reports, propaganda or intrigue directed by the enemy or other countries against our country, and to preserve our nation's strength until final victory is won.

The recent prohibition of listening to shortwave radio in the southern occupied areas was designed to block enemy propaganda. In other words, it was one means of thought control.

III. COUNTERINTELLIGENCE

Counterintelligence is the defense against foreign secret warfare directed at our country.

A. Meaning and Importance of Secret Warfare

Present-day warfare may be divided into two types. One is the conventional form of armed conflict, and the other is warfare without direct application of armed force. This latter type is called secret warfare. It is the destruction by peaceful means of the manpower and resources vital to a country's defense, by attacking her psychology, diplomacy and economy.

In the present era, when the military potential of different countries is more or less equal, an attempt to settle a conflict by

CONFIDENTIAL

military power alone prolongs the conflict and, by exhausting the national power of victor and vanquished alike, makes the postwar recovery of national strength very difficult. Thus there is a marked tendency to attempt to destroy the national defense of an opposing country, and to attain one's objectives swiftly by means other than armed conflict. In the world today, when cultures are closely related and have much in common, secret warfare is not only feasible but easy, and it has come to assume great importance.

Note 1. The use of secret warfare is not limited to time of war. During peace it is carried on in preparation for war.

Note 2. Elements of national defense:

Manpower: Population - quantity  
                  Psychology - quality

Material: Resources - quantity and quality  
                  Production - quantity and quality

In other words, the defense of a nation depends on both her psychological and her economic resources.

C. Counterintelligence and Field Military Police

Defense against secret warfare, entailing secret investigation and search, requires complete familiarity with human psychology and the real [internal] workings of society, and the [tactful] handling of delicate situations. This requires individuals with uniquely suitable personalities, who become specialists only after exhaustive training and long experience. In the field none but the Field Military Police are endowed with these qualifications. The Field Military Police must therefore utilize their special characteristics to block completely all enemy secret warfare, and [thereby] contribute to the achievement of the army's mission.

IV. HYPOTHETICAL SITUATIONS

1. After destroying the enemy forces around Kuala Lumpur on 13 September, a part of our force has the mission of policing the areas. This is hindered by the activities of enemy troops remaining in the vicinity.

2. The railroad between Singapore and Kuala Lumpur is blocked.

3. The 1st Company, Field Military Police, whose main strength policed the vicinity of Singapore, received an army order on 14 September to dispatch a part of the unit to Kuala Lumpur to police the area in cooperation with the local garrison unit.

Situation 1

2d Platoon, 1st Company (20 men including the commander), under Military Police 2d Lt YAMADA, receives an order on 14 September from the company commander to proceed immediately to police Kuala Lumpur.

**Problem :** What preparations should the platoon commander make before leaving?

**Solution:**

1. Gather information on conditions between Singapore and Kuala Lumpur.
2. Study the area in which security is to be maintained.
3. Assign responsibilities to subordinates.
4. Inspect military equipment and vehicles.
5. Plan the movement.
6. Prepare measures to cover any unexpected encounter with the enemy.
7. Take security measures.

**Explanation:**

Thorough preparation is very important. There are numerous actual examples of small ill-prepared units setting out in trucks and being caught off guard by attacks enroute. Therefore, the enemy situation along the route must be ascertained and appropriate countermeasures taken.

**Situation 2**

Superior Pvt A is ordered by the platoon commander to collect information on the situation between Singapore and Kuala Lumpur.

**Problem :** Should the Superior Pvt utilize the information gathered by his own unit? Through what other agencies should he get information? What information [should he get]?

**Solution:**

1. Get information about the garrison units, and about any other units stationed as garrisons, along the railway line between Singapore and Kuala Lumpur.

**Explanation:** Besides utilizing information gathered by his own unit, he must take advantage of useful information gathered by other units.

2. Information to be sought from other agencies:

Recent enemy activity; area where guerrillas are in hiding; villages and people hostile to the Japanese army; other areas where caution in movement is necessary.

Situation 3

Superior Pvt B, being in charge of counterintelligence, is ordered by the platoon commander to take necessary security measures with regard to persons working for the Military Police Unit (10 Malays and five Chinese), to insure secrecy on the unit's activities.

Problem : What security measures should Superior Pvt B take with regard to these employees?

Solution:

1. Conduct security training for the employees.
2. Prohibit the employees from leaving the unit's area, or seeing anyone.
3. Prohibit employees from using the telephone without permission, and carefully censor their mail.

Situation 4

The 20 men, including the platoon leader, arrive safely at Kuala Lumpur at 1100 hours, 21 September, and immediately commence collection of information relating to policing duties.

Problem : How does Cpl C go about getting this information?

Solution:

1. Get hold of and take advantage of [all the information which can be obtained from] secret agents, intelligence personnel and liaison personnel.
2. Make use of Chinese, Malayans, and the East Indians friendly to Japan.
3. Encourage informants.
4. Secretly keep a watch on suspicious individuals.

Situation 5

Cpl C orders a Superior Pvt to obtain secret agents.

Problem : How does the Superior Pvt go about obtaining secret agents?

Solution:

He should search out all persons in and around Kuala Lumpur who are friendly to Japan, susceptible to bribery or hostile to the enemy army, or who have relatives or friends in the enemy army or are carrying on activity beneficial to the enemy. By threats or other means he should make these persons secret agents.

Situation 6

On 21 September, a Chinese living in Kuala Lumpur came to Lance Cpl C and secretly informed him that a certain Chinese named Huang, also living in Kuala Lumpur, seemed to be observing the activity of the Japanese troops and reporting it somewhere.

Problem : What action should the Lance Cpl take?

Solution:

1. He should ascertain whether the information is correct, or whether the informant is simply trying to ruin a personal enemy. Ascertain the relation between the informant and the person he informed against.
2. If the information is judged correct, prepare to keep the suspect under continuous observation.

Explanation:

Chinese frequently inform against personal enemies to ruin them. Unquestioning reliance on informants will frequently result in being fooled by such scheming.

Situation 7

Lance Cpl A, in charge of five MP Superior Pvts and 15 local police, arrives at the state government building, which he has been ordered to guard. The building is three-storied, and observation of the vicinity from the roof is excellent.

Problem : Immediately after arriving at his post, what actions or security measures does the Lance Cpl take?

Solution:

He should assemble all his men on the roof top and acquaint them with the surrounding terrain. If time permits, he should also have them actually go over the ground.

Explanation:

Frequently only local information necessary to security is obtained, and the general situation is left obscure. It is especially important in unfamiliar areas to familiarize security personnel with nearby buildings and roads.

Situation 8

Problem : What should be the mental attitude of military police assigned to security?

Solution: They must have the determination to die at their post.

## Explanation:

~~SECRET~~

Military police have the bad habit of complaining about having to work with insufficient personnel. They must assume their duties with a serious determination to die heroically at their posts, if need be, as did the men at Attu.

Situation 9

Superior Pvt A discovers from the window of the state government building that five or six drunken soldiers from the garrison are molesting local inhabitants in the public square nearby.

Problem : What actions should Superior Pvt A take?

## Solution:

- He should quietly tell the soldiers he wishes to speak to them, and have them come into the government building.
- Explain to the soldiers that the local population should be treated as kindly as possible, that whether the inhabitants become friends or enemies depends on our attitude, and that they should be careful not to let such a thing happen again.

## Explanation:

In cautioning a person it is essential to explain the matter quietly and understandably, in a manner befitting the Military Police, and in a manner that produces a strong impression on the listener. (Arrogant admonitions will only produce antagonism.)

- Mohammedans go to any extent to avoid being struck in the presence of other people. Under no circumstances hit Mohammedans in front of others.

Situation 10

Problem: What attitude should the Military Police have towards the local population?

~~of violence of Japanese soldiers at Iwo Jima~~  
Solution:

Although those of the enemy who resist the Japanese Imperial Army should be destroyed, it is very important to treat kindly those who submit, and to make them believe that the Japanese are really the protectors of the local population.
