






# Facts as knowledge: Reminder

- **\*** Facts are knowledge
  - **Knowledge not always fact!**
  - **Example:** fear
- **\*** Best understanding of reality
- **\*** Facts change





# Facts as knowledge

A thing that is known to be true, especially when it can be proved

Oxford Learner's dictionaries

Something that is known to have happened or to exist, especially something for which proof exists, or about which there is information

Cambridge dictionary

Something that has actual existence, or a piece of information presented as having objective reality

# Nature of the knowledge: Etymology

Old English: fact


16th century | action, a thing done

17<sup>th</sup> century | a truth known by observation or authentic testimony 19<sup>th</sup> century | the stark realities of existence

# Facts as knowledge: Origin

#### **\*** Consensus

- **Agreement upon a false statement**
- Appeal to popularity fallacy
- Not Systematic (not scientific)

#### \* Reasoning

- Complex, hard to use & misleading
- Hard to understand



## Facts as knowledge: Definition

- **\*** What is the fact?
  - Different definitions: philosophy, law, history & science
- **\*** What is the scientific fact?
  - \* An objective and verifiable observation intended to explain or interpret natural or human-made phenomenon

#### Oxford dictionary of Science

ISBN 0-19-860757-1 (1999)

#### **Hypothesis**

A law that may not be universally true

**Theory** 

A description of nature that encompasses more than one law but has not achieved the incontrovertible status of a theorem

**Theorem** 

A descriptive principle of nature that holds in all circumstances covered. There are no loopholes in laws of nature and any exceptional event that did not comply with the law would require the existing Theorem to be discarded

Theory


Theoretical nature

**Example: Gravity** 


**Hypothesis:** throw object => go down


