1. V-12024(P) speaks perfect Czech and Slovatian, and GV C intends to use him as a translator (and perhaps as an interrogator) if traces disclose no derogatory information.

- 2. V-11672 has been in touch with V-12024(P) since 1950 and recommended him to V-11530. The GV C background check, in progress since 23 May 1951, has disclosed no derogatory information to date. V-12024(P) does not appear in the central ZIPPER card files.
- 3. V_11672 met V_12024(F) through the person named in para. 2 of reference. This person had known V-12042(P) for a long time and described him as trustworthy and a man of his word. V-12024(P) made a very good impression on V-11672. V-12024(P) has had no prior IS experience. GV C believes, however, that his perfect command of Czech and Slovakian will make him useful.


