1. Walter DOMES (true name) is the subject of reference. He was born on 21 November 1900 in Prerau, Maehren, of German parents. He graduated from schools in Olmuetz and Leipzig before volunteering and serving one year with the Austrian-Hungarian army. Thereafter he was taken over into the Czech army, given military training by that army, and assigned duty with it until his release on 1 May 1945 with the rank of lieutenant colonel. From September 1948 until 31 March 1951 he worked for STEG (Staatlichen Erfassungsgesellschaft). Since April 1951 he has held a subordinate position with Omnia, k.g., Munich 2, Prannerstr. He is married, 5'7", stocky, and brown-eyed, with a smooth-shaven oval face and greying hair. He lives at Dachau-Ost 20/7 a.

2. Omitted from para. 3 of reference is Dr. Ludwig NIEDOBA (true name), concerning whom nothing further is known. Traces on NIEDOBA are not requested.

Walter D...
1. V-12024(P) speaks perfect Czech and Slovakian, and GV C intends to use him as a translator (and perhaps as an interrogator) if traces disclose no derogatory information.

2. V-11672 has been in touch with V-12024(P) since 1950 and recommended him to V-11530. The GV C background check, in progress since 23 May 1951, has disclosed no derogatory information to date. V-12024(P) does not appear in the central ZIPPER card files.

3. V-11672 met V-12024(P) through the person named in para. 2 of reference. This person had known V-12042(P) for a long time and described him as trustworthy and a man of his word. V-12024(P) made a very good impression on V-11672. V-12024(P) has had no prior IS experience. GV C believes, however, that his perfect command of Czech and Slovakian will make him useful.

Walter Josef DOMES, born 21 November 1900 in Berau, CSR, KK BV-244 46, Reise Pass No. 451/1951, issued in Dachau on 12 July 1951, 172 cms. tall, oval face, brown eyes, living Dachau-Cst, is a former ZIPPER member. He used the alias Daniel WILDOLF, born 21 November 1900 in Pressburg, CSR, carried KK HP-III-H 587 963, issued on 2 August 1951 which expires 31 December 1954. Subject has now been dropped and ZIPPER does not recommend that CIC establish contact with him. ZIPPER states that Subject is indiscreet and produced virtually nothing. He is described by his associates in Sudeten German circles as being a "universal schwatzer".

Headquarters files reflect the following traces on Subject:

- a. EGIA-7340, dated 17 July 1951: Requested Headquarters traces on Walter DOMES, born 21 November 1900 in Prerau, Maschen, of German parents; graduated from schools in Olmütz and Leipzig before volunteering and serving one year with Austro-Hungarian Army. Thereafter taken into Czech Army, given military training and assigned there until released on 1 May 1945 with the rank of lieutenant colonel. From September 1948 to 31 March 1951 he worked for STEG (Staatlichen Erfassungsgesellschaft). Since April 1951 he has held a subordinate position with Omnia, k.g., Munich 2, Prannerstr. Married, 5'7", stocky, brown eyes, smooth shaven oval face, graying hair. Lives at Dachau-Cat 20/7a. Intention is to use him as a translator, and perhaps interrogator. Has had no previous IS experience.
- b. MEKW-10559, dated 13 September 1951: No Headquarters traces.
- c. EGSA-992 (undated): 66th CIC Identity Request Number 66-21-53, dated 27 March 1953: Subject, an official of the Sudetendeutsche Landsmannschaft in Munich, is presently under investigation by this Group to determine his suitability for employment. Subject reportedly was employed by an American sponsored organization known as "BFB" (Headquarters Note: UPHILL). Subject allegedly terminated his employment with this organization when the chief, one Josef MEK, died in 1952. It is requested that your office indicate if Subject is known to or associated with your organization.
- d. EGIA-3791, dated 26 May 1953: (reply to EGSA-992) DOMES is former UPHILL member; used alias Daniel WILDOLF, born 21 November 1900 in Pressburg, CSR; has now been dropped and UPHILL does not recommend that CIC establish contact with him. UPHILL states that Subject is indiscreet and produced virtually nothing; he is described by his associates in Sudeten German circles as being a "universal Schmeitser (babbler)."
- e. EGHA-0865, dated 16 July 1953: Transmitting list of dropped agents and informants, including Subject, alias Walter DRAHA, and alias Daniel WILDOLF (sic), dropped in April 1953 without prejudice.
- f. EGQA-75972/3: Enclosed request for name check from 7050th Air Intelligence Service Wing (USAFE) dated September 1956 on Subject. Frankfurt Station replied that he had been dropped by USAFEUR.
