Re Baltimore letter dated August 27, 1958, advising of results of interview of PCI MAX GOLDBERG, CPA, in Baltimore, on August 21, 1958.

On November 17, 1958, Mrs. [REDACTED] 3701 Clarnith Road, Baltimore, Maryland, advised she is the sister of MAX GOLDBERG and is employed as a secretary in his office.

Mrs. [REDACTED] also advised that Mr. GOLDBERG is critically ill in the New Kensington General Hospital suffering from an ulcerated colon and other complications. She further advised that doctors have advised that this illness could be fatal and, if not, will cause Mr. GOLDBERG to be incapacitated for sometime.

Mrs. [REDACTED] also advised that she was certain subject, SEBASTIAN JOHN LA ROCCA, had not contacted Mr. GOLDBERG or any members of his staff since the previous interview. She stated that if subject does contact any member of Mr. GOLDBERG's organization, she will immediately advise the Baltimore Office.

In view of the physical condition of PCI GOLDBERG, and the fact that he does not appear to be in a position to furnish continuing information concerning criminal activities, no further effort will be made to recontact him as a PCI in the absence of a specific request.
