She further advised that doctors have advised that this illness could be fatal and, if not, will cause Mr. GOLDBERG to be incapacitated for sometime. also advised that she was certain subject, SEBASTIAN JOHN LA ROCCA, had not contacted Mr. GOLDBERG or any members of his staff since the previous interview. She stated that if subject does contact anymember of Mr. GOLDBERG's organization, she will immediately advise the Baltimore Office.
