Your kind peditious instruction will be greatly appreciated.

1. Reason for application.

Ashikaga Factory of Fuji Ind. Co, Ltd., which had been a weaving plant in the prewar days, was transferred to Nakajima Aircraft Co. in the wartime. At present the reparation machines and equipments are kept in that factory.

Tokyo Woolen Ind. Co. Ltd., with the purpose to contribute to restoration of Japanese fibre industry, made negotiation for transfer of the land, buildings and annexed establishments of that factory with Fuji Ind. Co. 

1. The Ashikaga Factory of Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd. had belonged to Ashikaga Spinning Co., Ltd. till October 1943 when it was inevitably handed over to the then Nakajima Aircraft Corporation (at present: Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd.).

2. Founding the Tokyo Woollen Industry Co., Ltd. in January 1947 to rehabilitate a woollen spinning plant at the Factory above mentioned, we are to install some sets of woollen spinning machinery there and also worsted spinning machinery will shortly be equipped.

Refined export fabric in wool is to be produced by full use of those installations as well as of special arts in mixed woollen spinning.

3. The Factory concerned was, at our first plan, intended to be loaned us; but the present owner, namely: Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd., designated to be a restricted company in February 1946, has been under instructions of so-called "Zaibatsu" dissolution and we are to take over the Factory to ourselves in future. An application has been submitted to GHQ, SCAP for permission of property disposition concerned; reference is to be made to the copies of documents concerned.

4. After the contract being carried out, the Factory above mentioned is to be loaned to Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd. and designated reparations items will be maintained with best care as they have ever been.


5. The Factory being a custodial plant, we have been authorized to employ it with respective permits, as listed below:

A contract is to be made on sale of the Ashikaga Factory (herein below given as "Factory") belonging to Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd. between Fuji Industrial Co., Ltd. (herein below given as "A") and Fuji Textile Industry Co., Ltd. (at present: Tokyo Woollen Industry Co., Ltd.; herein below given as "B"), the sale terms being as defined below.

Article One. "A" is to transfer land, buildings, attached facilities, in their existing state, as stated in the annexed lists, owned by "A" and located at No. 600, Yawata, Yamabe-machi, Ashikaga-gun, Tochigi-ken, to "B" at ¥10,000,000.00 (ten million yen); "B" is to obtain them by the transfer. the



We are manufacturing export electric bulb making machines (Automatic Anker inserting Machine) at present in our two factories, i.e. the Ashikaga Factory (760, 1-chome, Sukedo, Ashikaga-shi) and Naka-cho Factory (500, Naka-cho, Sukedo). And we have been using the 23 machines for reparation by your permission.

Among the 23 machines, we are going to remove the following 18 machines which are installed in the Naka-cho Factory to the Ashikaga Factory.

Reason required for the Removal.

1. In the Naka-cho Factory, we installed carding machines (occupies about two thirds of the factory area) in a part of the factory, and are engaging in spinning.

As the operation is apt to cause a fire, we wish to remove the reparation machines of the Naka-cho Factory to a safer place for their charge.

2. The Ashikaga Factory is surrounded by fields and is more favorably situated for fire prevention than the Naka-cho Factory. In consequence, the probability of getting a fire is very scarce.

3. With resumption of foreign trade, demands for export electric bulbs become very large, and orders for the bulb making machines have greatly increased.

Thus we wish to get a roll in the development of export industry of our country, increasing our productive capacity, by bringing together the machines of the Naka-cho Factory to the Ashikaga Factory.

These two factories are about 500 meters distant; we shall pay our best attention to make least damage to the machines in their transportation.

As the circumstance stands as above, we should like you would grant us permission for the application.

Memorandum as is stated in detail in the letters referred to in Paragraph 2. above, General Headquarters, Supreme Commander for the Allied Powers is requested to be good enough to grant approval to the subject application.

(A) That the product to be produced is essential to the needs of the Japanese economy.

The rehabilitation of textile industry is urgent and prerequisite for the reconstruction of peace industry of postwar Japan. Woolen Yarn, one of the leading products of textile industry, shall be consumed for the manufacture of export woolen

fabric in order to contribute, through woolen yarn industry, to the reconstruction of Japan's economy.

- (B) That other facilities than the subject of reparation can not be available and that it is unnecessary that the location of production be transferred after the removal of facilities for reparation.
- (1) The establishment of this plant, as a cotton spinning manufactory, by Ashikaga Spinning Company, Ltd. dates back to 1917 and though purchased, during the war, compulsorily by Fuji Industrial Company, this plant is most fitted as a spinning manufactory because of the original purpose of this plant.
- (2) All round reconversion of this plant is projected by utilizing facilities including buildings and accessories connected with such equipment as switch-board, steaming and pumping equipment, absolutely necessary equipment for the manufacture of woolen yarn. Further, there is no facilities either similar or to be reconstructed to meet the present purpose.
- (3) Spinning shall be carried on by machines that will be transferred from other places and are expected to be installed completely by June, 1947. No machines, in general, designated for reparation will be used.

As mentioned above the present application implies only the permission of the use for certain period of buildings and facilities fixed to them and they shall be separated completely from those designated for reparation. The Fuji Textile Company shall, as a matter of course, use every means for the custody

and maintenance of the facilities designated for reparation and more-over, shall not avoid to take any trouble for the prosecution of satisfactory packing and shipping attending to the dismantling of the said facilities.

Further, your approval of the present application is especially desired in earnest in consideration of the fact that the permission both of inauguration of enterprise and of the adjustment of funds has been obtained.

Remarks:

1. The title of Fuji Textile Company Ltd. was altered as Tokyo Spinning and Weaving Company, Ltd. (Tokyo Boshoku Kabushiki Kaisha) on 1 May 1947.
2. Application on the same line with the subject matter, for exemption of the part of facilities from reparation has been submitted through C.I.O.
