

The bombing run was made against imptallations in SASA TURN in 14's 7474. 7673 and 7674. Hits were made in the area. but no specific regults were observed. A level run was made against these terrets.

The Avergers them made a rocket run against buildings in MAKADA TOWN in southern OKIMANA SHIMA, and three or four fires were observed upon leaving the area.
