ACTIVITIES



○ 1 syllabus used

1 Project Assistant recruited



2 sessions of Wikipedia classes launched in November



○ 1st year students of an engineering school

A class at WCUG-CI headquarters



○ 18 sessions lasting 2hrs, since November 2016

8 trainers



37 attendees overall

33 respondents after a call for applications shared online via the Newsletter, Facebook, etc.

RESULTS/IMPACT



16 new editors among whom are 6 women

14% was the average presence rate



8 #WLW articles edited (create & improved)

1 certified

1 new member of WCUG-CI

66 edits in 2 months



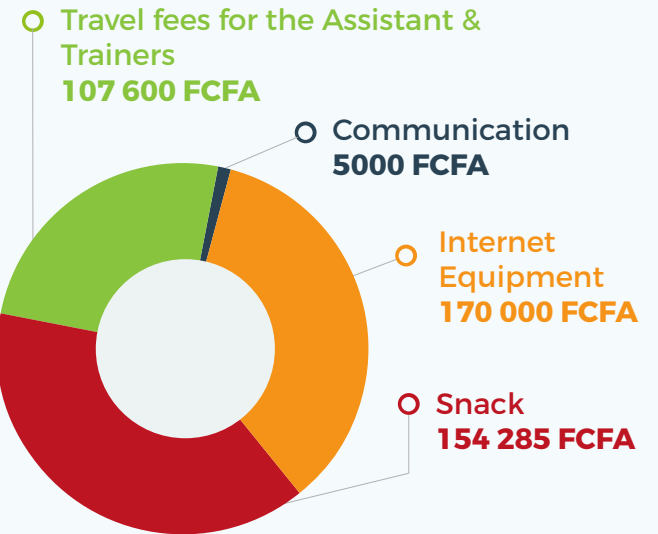
○ Stronger commitment of the Project Assistant who the acting Deputy treasurer, elected member

LESSONS LEARNED

- Internet and projector issues can be a rough handicap to training sessions. WikiPack was used as an alternative for off-line editing.
- 9-12 weeks is somewhat long. Consider a shorter format of 4-5 weeks, while including at least an edit-a-thon with WCUG-CI
- The syllabus served as a good guide, but needs to be adapted to our local context and in French.
- Equipment is needed: get a projector and a working internet connection
- Being more strict during the selection process to make sure participants will effectively attend
