

The Project

With the support of a **financial grant provided by** <u>Arcadia</u>, Wikimedia Deutschland wants to create a prototype of a collaboration with the purpose of enabling another movement group to contribute to the software development of Wikidata and Wikibase in a sustainable and scalable way. We want to create a long term, sustainable environment for the lexicographical data part of Wikidata with a local community group that is connected to under-resourced and/or under-represented languages.

During the beginning of the project, we have conducted a series of interviews with Wikimedia Deutschland staff to find out about our **values and visions when entering such a partnership** in the Wikimedia community.

Visions for the Movement

Decentralize the movement

Local development teams will work together with development teams in WMDE and the WMF to make existing projects more diverse and fill the needs of more diverse groups and under-resourced communities.

Scale up partnerships and collaborations

The movement will see more collaborations and partnerships like this and affiliates working together, sharing their resources to work on projects and products together. Partnerships like this will work globally and translocally and include several partners.

Visions for Lexicographical Data and Wikidata

Reach more people that can benefit from language software

Working with their languages in the digital sphere and specifically in the Wikimedia projects and Wikidata will be easy and appealing for under-resourced or underrepresented language communities.

The Wikimedia projects and -specifically Wikidata- will accommodate non-Western language and knowledge systems with ease.

Wikidata being the basis for people accessing the digital sphere in their languages

There will be enough content on under-resourced languages to power Abstract Wikipedia.

Applications, linguistic research or media are available for all languages, based on the lexicographical data that language communities add and maintain in Wikidata.
