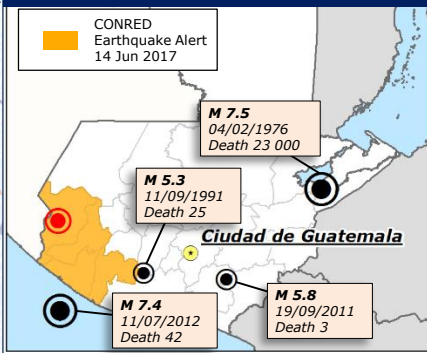


SITUATION

- An earthquake of magnitude 6.9 M at the depth of 94 km hit the department of San Marcos on 14 June at 7.29 (UTC).
- As of 15 June at 17.00 (UTC), national authorities report that in Guatemala: five people have died, 19 people were injured 3 141 people were affected and 118 buildings were damaged in the departments of San Marcos, Quetzaltenango, Suchitepequez and Retalhuleu. A number of landslides also occurred on the roads of Atlatic and Retalhuleu.
- National Coordinator for Natural Disaster Risk Reduction has declared an Orange Alert in the departments of San Marcos, Quetzaltenango, Suchitepequez and Retalhuleu. The assessment of damages is ongoing.
