## Announce at search placeholder

When a page has multiple uses, we can use the search bar to announce that. When the user taps on the search bar, the different alternatives will populate the initial search results. So the user can either jump to an alternative result or search for another topic.

### Pros

- Avoid pushing the content below
- Make the search bar more contextual

### Cons

- It may be missed by users if they jump directly to the content. Bold text has been used to call for attention, but that may not be enough.
- It can hide the search function. Will users looking for regular search assume that search is there?

## Reflect current article in search bar

Regardless of accessing the article by search or by links, the search bar may have the article title as if the user had searched for it. This allows to attach additional article info next to it.

### Pros

- Avoid pushing the content below
- Make the search bar more contextual

### Cons

- Redundancy with the article title
- Too much call for attention cluttering the top bar
- Search functionality may get hidden for the user.

### Cons

- There is not much room so info needs to be presented in a very compact way.
- If the different areas (search, title, and tools) start getting sub-divided, the top area can get too cluttered.
