Six 1/S planes on the Bast side of the runsay were straffed and hit with fragmentation books. They did not burn and appeared already desaged. Sen S/S planes on the runsays were observed to be already inoperational. Resket and strafing runs were made in revetted areas where 5 or 6 S/S planes were seen. Requits unobserved...an unprofitable and dangerous target as were most of the A/F's covered by this AG. Observations of field 356 showed same negative results as day before. One engine was definitely bloom up and left steeming on the railroad track.
