Two F6F-5PT aircraft under Ensign R. JUNG, flight leader, took off from Agana Airfield, Guam, M. I. on 20 April 1945 at 0930 King to photograph enemy installations on Rota Island. They arrived over the target at 1115 King and took vertical photographs of Rota Airfield from an altitude of 5,000 ft. Following the photographic runs, they strafed Rota village and a truck driving along the beach on the eastern side of the islands. Results were not observed. The planes returned to base at 1145 King.
