Many of the oldest gravestones in this cemetery erected during the '30's, '40's, were formed from a soft grade of marble, and present much evidence of natural disintegration. The inscriptions are completely obliterated from a few, and many others are slowly disappearing. Many of those given herewith were deciphered with difficulty. Several of the older slabs were broken in pieces, and a few broken off near the ground had been re-set to a depth covering parts of the inscriptions.)
