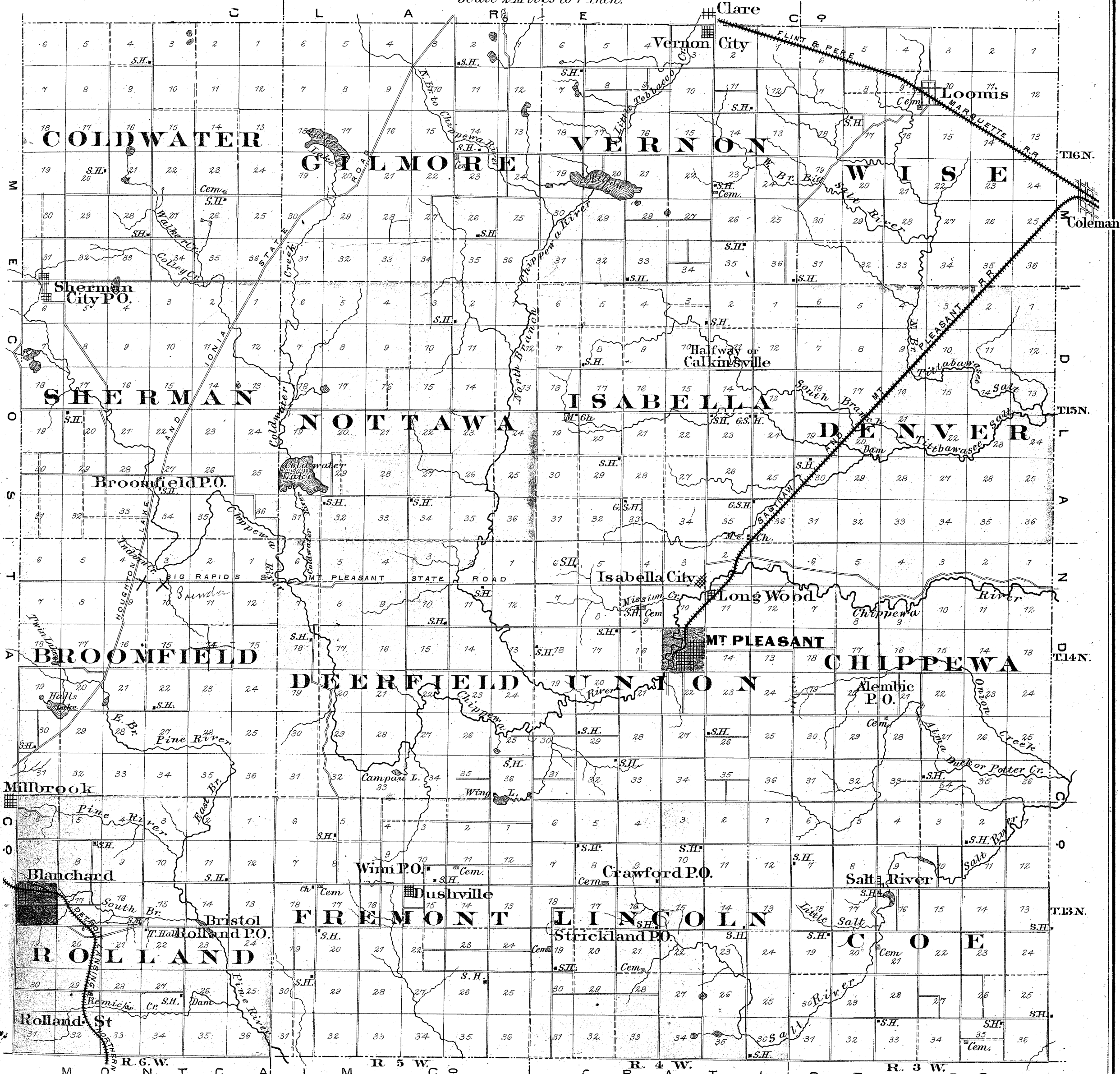

CAHOON'S PLAT 1870

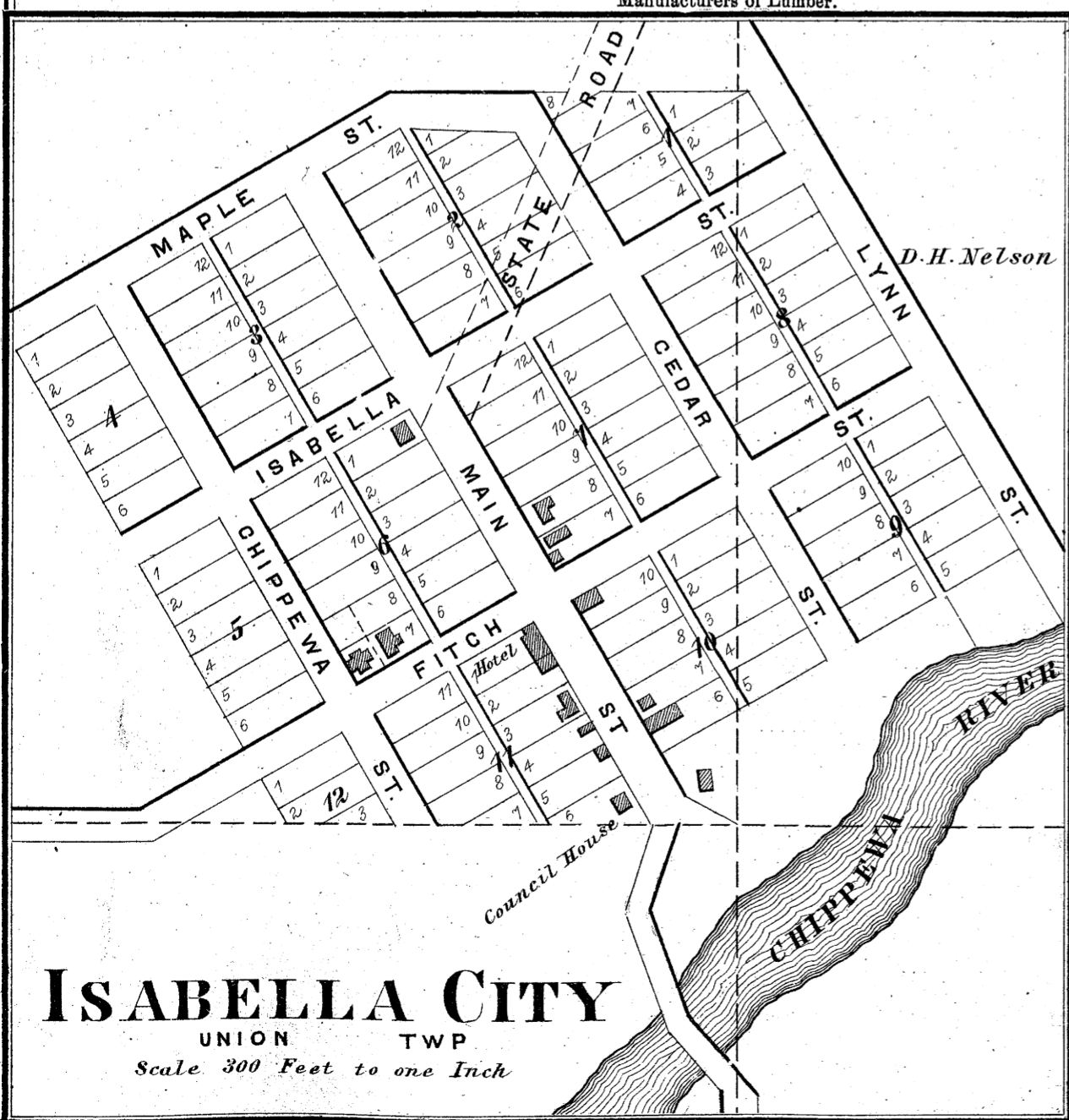

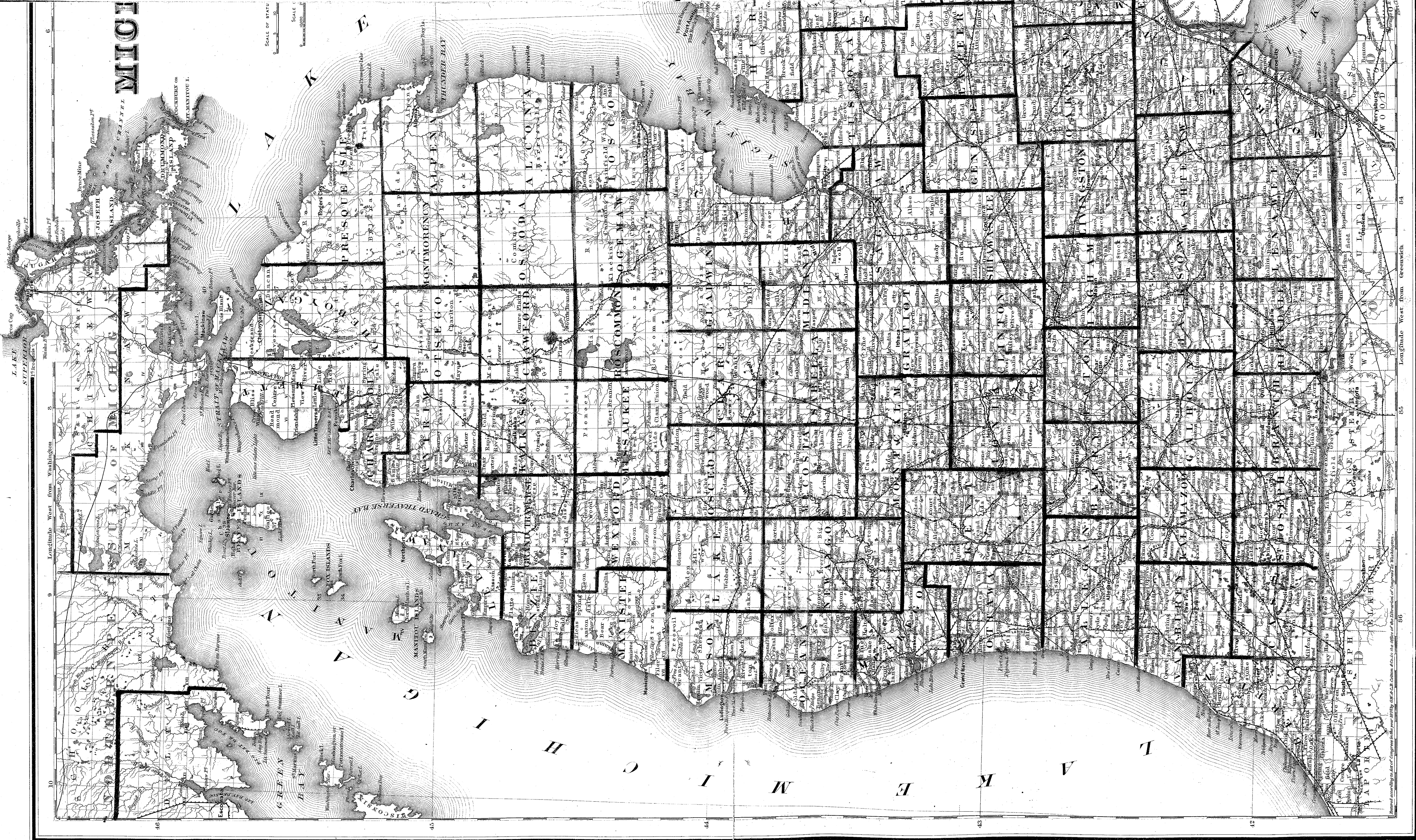

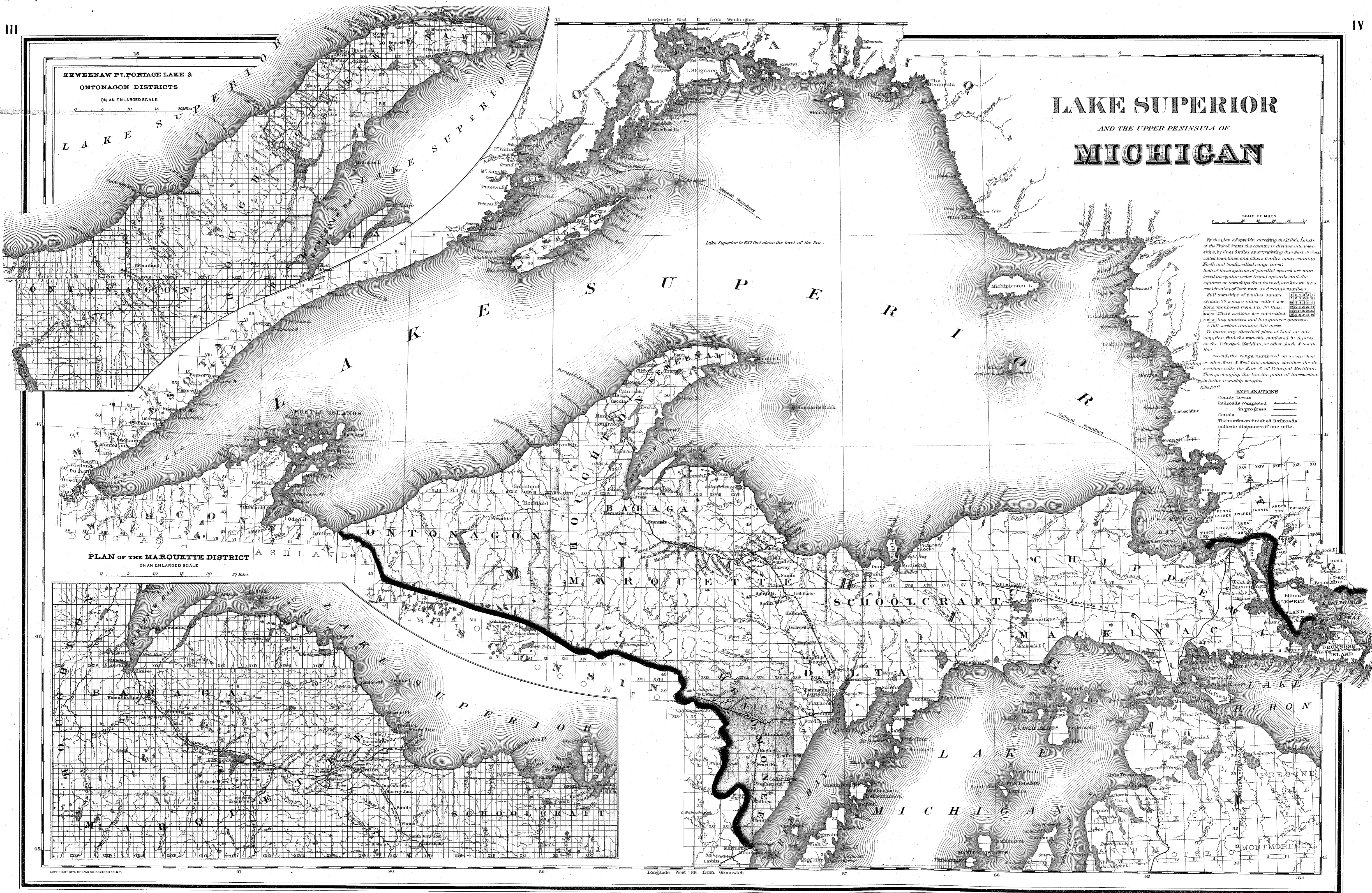

By the plan adopted in surveying the Public Lands of the United States, the country is divided into townships, by lines 36 miles apart, running due East & West, called town lines, and others 6 miles apart, running North and South, called range lines. Both of these systems of parallel spaces are numbered in regular order from 1 upwards, and the squares or townships thus formed, are known by a combination of both town and range numbers. Each township of 36 miles square contains 36 square miles called sections, numbered from 1 to 36 thus: 1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36. These sections are subdivided into quarters and into quarter quarters. A full section contains 360 acres. To locate any described piece of land on this map, first find the township, numbered in figures on the Principal Meridian, or other North & South line, around the range number, on a section or other East & West line, noting whether the description calls for E. or W. of Principal Meridian. Then, prolonging the two, the point of intersection is in the township sought.

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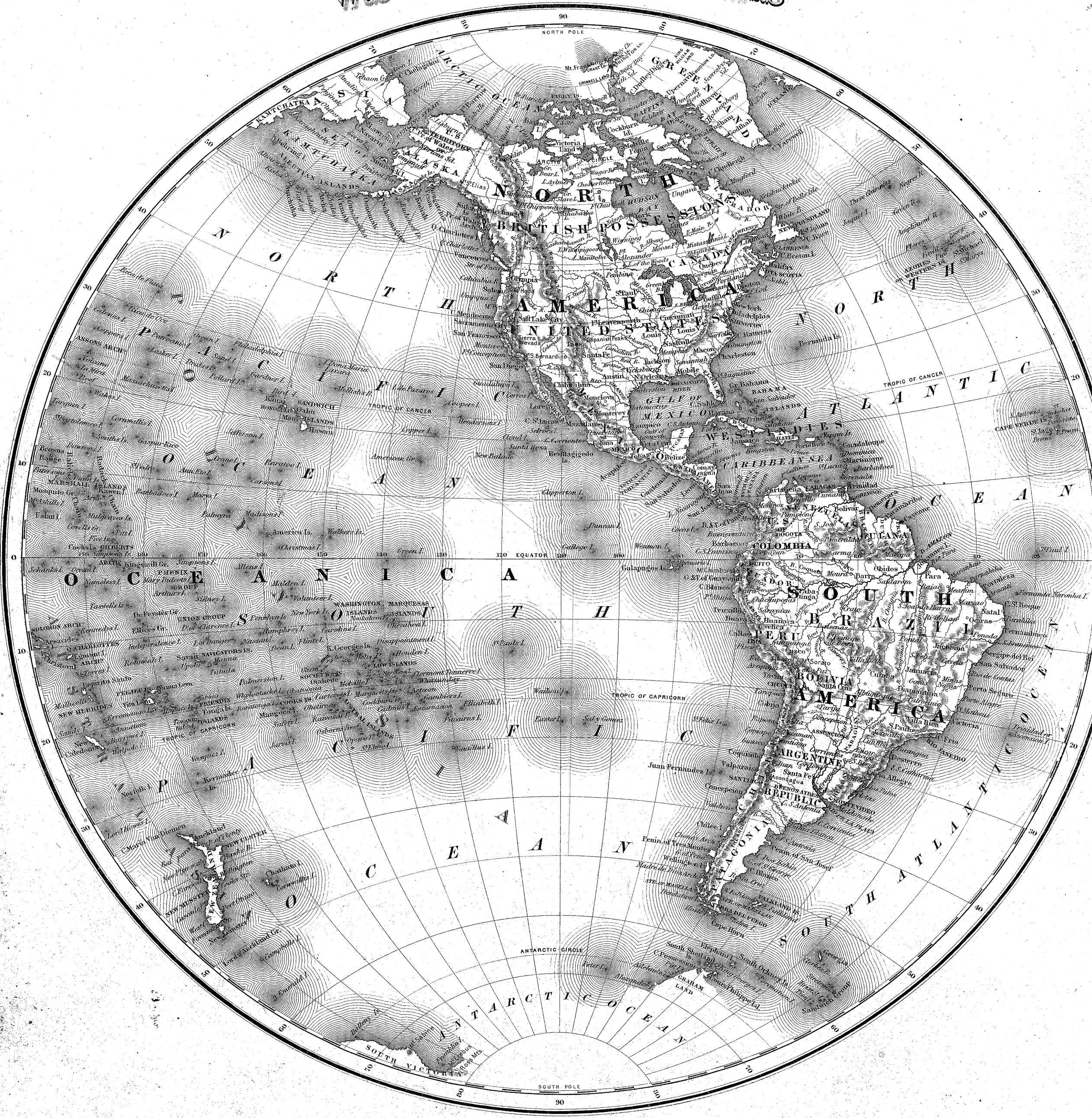
