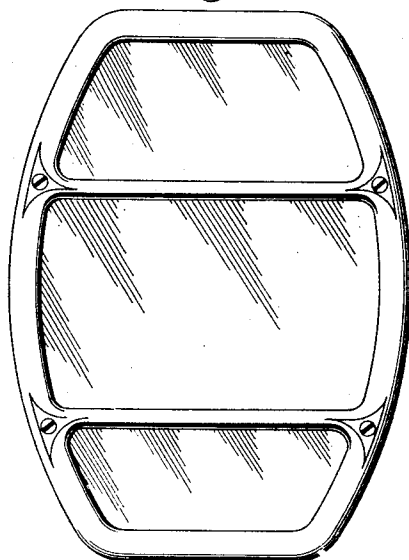

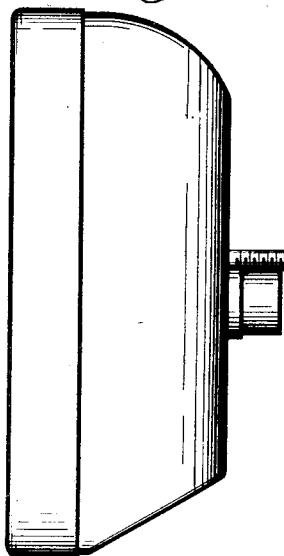
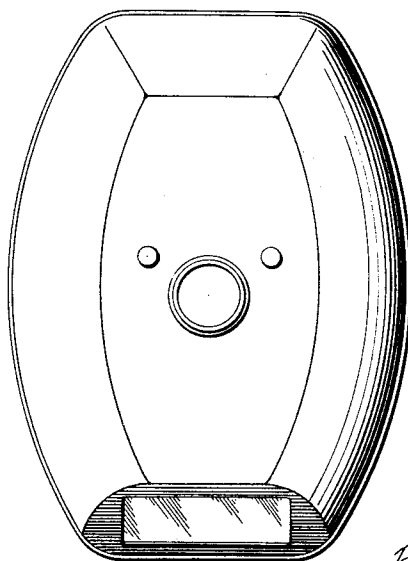

DESIGN FOR A VEHICLE TAIL LAMP

Application filed December 7, 1929. Serial No. 33,700. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that BORNETT L. BOBROFF, a citizen of the United States, residing at Racine, in the county of Racine and State of Wisconsin, has invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Vehicle Tail Lamps, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a face view of the vehicle tail lamp showing my new invention.

Figure 2 is a side view of the lamp.

Figure 3 is a view of the lamp from the opposite side from that shown in Figure 1.
